





LINCOLNSHIRE HISTORY:

By: the "new - old timers"

......Continued - - -

ake Largo" existed just east of the current LARGO CENTRAL PARK area before the dam that was constructed making LAKE SEMINOLE stole the lake from our area. Unknown to most, hunters killed the last deer in the area which was Lake Largo.

The lake was there – one of the prettiest lakes you ever saw.

ALLIGATORS—lots of them, and nobody fooled with them. People walked down to the lake, and they had boats there. Nothing to rent, but just boats. It was a destination on Sunday afternoons—no cars in your way. If it was a river instead of a lake it could be the inspiration for "Cruising Down the river on a Sunday afternoon"



Then came the "lake Largo – Cross Bayour Drainage project" in 1915. I wouldn't want to figure out what the \$120,00 project would cost today, but 2 large canals and about 57 miles of ditches were created to drain the 13,127-acre district south and east of Largo. The higher ground contained groves, cane fields, ponds, and lakes. The object was to drain lower lands to make acreage available for growing vegetables, hay, and other agricultural products.

It was found that the lake had a flowing artesian well. It's still there . . . but loaded with sulfur. In 1945 the water in the city went salty and you couldn't drink it, so the city actually hooked on to that well and used that water for the city. - - and there are people today who don't like the city water - - good thing you weren't around then

He completed one air combat tour in Viet Nam aboard the aircraft carrier Enterprise. He finished his naval service as a senior Lieutenant in the Naval Reserve Corp. Guy also wore the Viet Nam Service ribbon.

Guy continued his association with military and civil aviation in his business career until moving to Florida in the late 1990's. Not stopping even then until his passing in December of 2019 he rose to the rank of Division Captain for the Coast Guard Axillary with zone responsibility for Tampa Bay Intracoastal Waterway. He often patrolled in his personal motor craft. Guy was also a licensed CG Master Sea Captain and often proctored the Coast Guard's Sea Captain Examinations in addition to sea/ocean navigation. 

VETERAN'S CORNER

Latest Estimate Puts 'Record' Military Retiree COLA Increase in Doubt

fter spending much of 2022 on a steady rise, the monthly figures used to calculate annual raises for military retirees, Social Security recipients, VA disability payees, and others have leveled off in recent months, ending talk of a potential double-



digit cost-of-living adjustment (COLA). The latest estimate by the nonpartisan Senior Citizens League puts the 2023 COLA at 8.7%, on par with the adjustment received by military retirees on March 1, 1982. It's important to note the adjustment's calculations have changed frequently over the past 40 years. The current military-retiree COLA calculation, using the Consumer Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers (CPI-W), is also used to determine the Social Security COLA, but that wasn't always the case; Social Security recipients received a 7.4% COLA in 1982, for example, following an 11.2% boost the previous year.




