



Veteran's Day

ovember 11 marks an important day, a day to honor and thank all military personnel who have served, or currently serve in the United States Armed Forces. We have many veterans here in our community who deserve recognition; but on this Veteran's Day I would like to tell you the story of one of those veterans – Charles Slamin.



Charlie, from Natick Massachusetts, was a young man working at the National Guard Building/Army-Air Force Supply Depot when he felt it was his responsibility to enlist.

"That day in high school, I had other things on my mind. I just left school and headed straight to the Enlistment Office. When I returned home, I told my parents that I enlisted in the United States Navy. My mother was very upset and said 'No'; but my father said 'Yes, he will be called soon enough'. I enlisted because the war was on, and I didn't want to be drafted into the army. It was 1943 and I was 17 years old".

Following basic training at the Naval Station in Newport, Rhode Island, Coxswain Charlie was stationed on LST-75 heading for the European Theatre. After participating in military operations in North Africa he proceeded to England to take part in the Normandy Invasion. He

operated a LCVP transporting troops to shore and picking up the wounded. "On my first trip to the beach I was battling 8-foot waves when I hit an underwater obstacle scraping the bottom of the boat creating a hole".

In March 1945 his naval task unit #2 assisted in four assault crossings of the Rhine River by the Third Army. "Germans threw all kind of shells at you; if you crossed the Rhine, you knew the war was over". General Patton commended each and every man of the US Naval Task Unit #2 for their superior manner in which tasks were performed.

Upon leaving the European Theatre, "I was given a 30-day leave then was sent to California and put on a ship to Okinawa".

"One night I was asleep on the bottom bunk and I heard a voice say 'get up, get up'I asked is anyone awake? When no one answered I decided to go for coffee and the next thing I knew a shell (dud) came down and hit the guy in the top bunk above mine. He was sleeping on his side and the shell sliced off both forearms. I asked around 'who told me to get up?' no one did. I guess that shell didn't have my name on it. It's been 79 years and I still can't get rid of the memories".

Two and half years in the military, Boatswain Mate Second Class Charlie was finally going home.

When Charlie returned home, he went back to work at the National Guard Building/Army-Air Force Supply Depot, then began investing his money in purchasing several gas stations. In the last six years of employment, he worked for the City of Natick in the highway department.

I hope by reading this story, people might embrace some lessons of gratitude, giving back, and counting one's blessings in life.






