There are certificates available to present to your insurance company. If you wish to have one, you can email tiedownprogram@gulfcoast.edu to request a certificate to be emailed to you. If your home is not on the list, it may be due to your home sitting too low and they were unable to complete the service OR the previous owner declined to have it done. I have put Teakwood on a revisit list for those homes that have not had it done.

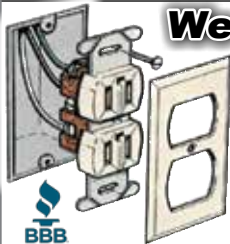

It's November and the autumn crispness is upon us. Don't forget that Daylight Saving Time end on Sunday, November 6, so clocks go back. I understand that they are trying to eliminate DST, this has not happened yet.

The end of September, Mother Nature threw us for a loop. Teakwood Village would like to go over a few things with our residents so we all have the same info should this happen again.

1. Storm prep: Make sure that your home is secure. Clean up your yard and secure inside your home or shed anything that could become airborne with high winds. Notify your family and friends if you are leaving or staying and how to contact you (this is not thru the Teakwood offices).
2. After the storm, Teakwood Village staff will clear the streets and common areas (entrance ways and clubhouses). It is your responsibility to clear storm debris from your yard.
3. If you are outside of Teakwood, make sure that you have a friend or family member who can check on your home. Teakwood Village will not check individual homes. If there is damage that is not hugely evident from the street, we will not see it. Teakwood Village does not have the staff to check each home and we will not do a walk around, check the roof and interiors. Have someone you trust do this for you.
4. Make sure if you are staying, that your family/friends, contact the Largo Police Department at 727-587-6730 for a wellness check if you do not answer your phone or if the telephone service is out.

I pray that we don't need this information, but keep it on hand just in case.

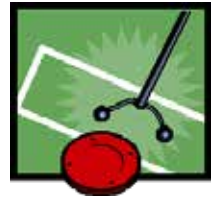


KOFFEE KLATCH from the Social Club

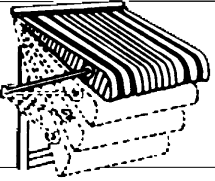

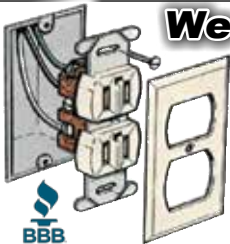

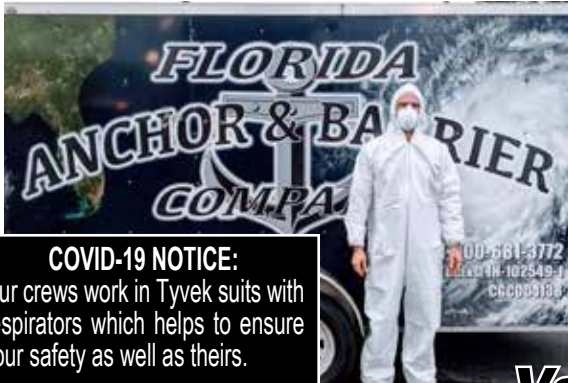

Italian sausage stuffing

16-oz day old bread cut into 1-inch pieces

1 tablespoon extra-virgin olive oil

1pd of any kind of sausage (I use sweet sausage)

1/3 cup unsalted butter

1 cup chopped yellow onion

1 cup chopped celery (3 stalks)

1/2 cup chopped flat leaf parsley

1 tablespoon fresh chopped rosemary
(no stems)

1 tablespoon fresh chopped sage

1/2 teaspoon sea salt or to taste

2 cups low sodium vegetable broth

1 egg lightly whisked

Preheat oven to 350 degrees

Place the cube bread on baking sheet bake 7-10 min until toasted or golden brown- then place into a large bowl add 2 cups of broth to a large saucepan, heat on medium -low

Meanwhile in a large skillet heat the oil over medium heat. Cook the sausage over medium heat for about 10 min. until brown. In another skillet add oil, onion, celery, parsley, sage, rosemary. Add a dash of salt and pepper and sauté over medium heat for about 10 minutes or until vegetables are soft. Add the browned sausage, toasted bread to a large bowl. Next, add in the onion mixture. Add in 1 cup broth. With a large spoon, gently stir the ingredients together. Add in the whisked egg. Gradually add the remaining broth 1/4 cup at a time until the stuffing is wet. With each addition, gently stir and pat the stuffing ingredients together. Do not over mix it, and do not make it dripping wet. When broth is soaked in and combined, spoon the stuffing into a 2qt baking dish or 9x12 inch baking dish. Cook for 30-40 minutes, or until heated through and golden brown on top. Check it at 25 minutes... if it seems to brown quicker cover with foil. I bake mine for a good 40 minutes. When you remove it from the oven sprinkle with parsley, then serve.

Sweet Potato Casserole

4 large Sweet Potatoes cut into 1-inch pieces. boil 10-15 minutes then mash till creamy.

3 large eggs,

1/2 cup sugar

6 tablespoons melted butter

1/2 tablespoons vanilla

Pour mixture into hot sweet potatoes and beat well, add 1 cup dried cranberries, put into 9x13 dish



Topping

2/3 brown sugar

3 tablespoons cold butter

1/3 cup flour

1 cup coarsely pecans






Bake 35-40 minutes

Sprinkle over casserole dish, add marshmallows/broil til golden brown
