

MANAGER'S CORNER:

HURRICANE SEASON 2022

If an evacuation order is issued, Palm Hill is a mandatory evacuation zone as are all mobile home communities. Should you choose to remain in the park and need medical or emergency assistance, the authorities will not respond as they will be dealing with other emergencies, and you should have heeded the evacuation order.

The nearest shelter is Largo High School 410 Missouri N. Largo; this is a pet friendly shelter but will fill up quickly. The 2 Clubhouses here in Palm Hill <u>are not</u> rated as hurricane shelters and therefore cannot be used by residents as a shelter. Due to Liability issues both clubhouses will be locked down when an evacuation order is issued.
