



"If you want other people to be better at what they do, then you must make yourself better at what you do.







Safety tips for preparing and serving community meals

Preparing and storing food for large groups has different requirements than preparing smaller meals. Here are some tips on how to prepare safe community meals from the USDA, Food Safety and Inspection Service:

- Make a good plan. Make sure that the location you pick has enough oven, stovetop, refrigerator and freezer space. Make sure there is also a source of clean water to use.
- Safely store and prepare food. Perishables need to be refrigerated or frozen within two hours of prepara-tion or shopping. Always make sure you use separate areas to prepare raw and cooked foods. Remember to never place



prepare raw and cooked foods. Remember to never place cooked food back on a cutting board or surface where something raw has been. Wash your hands, utensils and cutting boards frequently while you are preparing foods. Use hot soapy water.

- Make sure that the internal temperature of the foods you cook reaches a high enough temperature to kill bacteria. Use a food thermometer so that you can check internal temperatures accurately. Make sure you check in several places so that you get a true reading. Don't partially cook your food with the plan to finish cooking it later. This could encourage the growth of harmful bacteria.
- To transport food safely you will need to keep your hot foods hot and your cold foods cold. Use coolers for cold foods and make sure the temperature is 40 degrees or below. Keep your hot foods at a temperature of 140 degrees. Wrap it well and place it inside an insulated container.
- When you reheat your food make sure you bring it up to a temperature that makes it hot and steamy. Just warming it up is not safe. Bring the temperature of the food up to 165 degrees. Soups, sauces and gravies need to be brought to a boil.
- Use steam tables or warming trays to keep your hot foods hot—that means at or above 140 degrees. Keep your cold food at or below 40 degrees.
- If you know that food has been left out at room temperature for more than two hours, the safest thing to do is throw it out. If you have leftovers, you will want to place them in shallow containers and refrigerate or freeze them immediately.


