

### GARBAGE GARBAGE GARBAGE RECYCLE RECYCLE

This is your friendly reminder about what should and shouldn't go into each of those green bins that are in two places in the park. There are garbage bins and ONE recycle bin. The garbage ONLY goes into the bin marked garbage. Garbage must be bagged and placed in that container. Branches and yard waste must be no longer than 30 inches. No televisions, electrical items or furniture can be thrown away in



the bins. If you have large items to dispose of, take them to the city dump. Ask anyone on the board for directions to their site.

There is only one recycle bin and it is clearly marked with a sign explaining what will be accepted at the recycling center. In order to be compliant with their rules, we ask that NO glass be discarded in that bin. Styrofoam is not accepted as well as plastic bags of any kind. In order to conserve space in the bin, thus less money for us, we ask that you crush your plastic water bottles and remove the caps. Those caps become missiles when they go thru the machines. Also break down all boxes so they lay flat. You would be surprised at the amount of space that saves.

Finally, I know many of you follow the guidelines and do your part so we don't lose the recycling privilege. However, there are some that don't and this is a problem. I for one, and



there are others, that are tired of dumpster diving to fish out Styrofoam and wine bottles that have been placed in wrong bin. The buckets that are on the side of the bins are for aluminum beer and soda cans. These are crushed by fellows in the park and taken to the recycle facility. They are weighed, and the money is given to us, which is also used to supplement our social expenses. Owners must inform your guests of the guide lines especially if you are not with them when they stay in Boca Ciega.

Remember, that everyone needs to do their part to keep our little piece of heaven in ship shape operating condition.




