

Ask yourself if your expectations are too low

o you know what the Pygmalion effect is? It is how our expectations of others often end up becoming a self-fulfilling prophecy. For instance, according to Edith Hamilton's classic, Mythology, Pygmalion was a young and gifted sculptor, and he set out to make a beautiful statue of a woman. He worked and worked and had such high expectations of his statue that he began to treat it as if it were a real woman. Eventually, through his own desire and treatment of his creation and with the help of Venus, the statue was actually transformed into a flesh-and-blood woman.



The principle is also illustrated in George Bernard Shaw's play Pygmalion. In that story, Eliza Doolittle, a Cockney flower girl, is taken on by a professor who says that he can pass her off as a duchess. He pulls it off, but Eliza has this to say to his friend: "You see, really and truly, apart from the things anyone can pick up (the dressing and the proper way of speaking and so on), the difference between a lady and a flower girl is not how she behaves, but how she's treated. I shall always be a flower girl to Professor Higgins, because he always treats me as a flower girl, and always will, but I know I can be a lady to you because you always treat me like a lady, and always will."

In an experiment conducted in 1968 by psychologist Robert Rosenthal, the same principle was illustrated. All of the children in the experiment were given a nonverbal test of intelligence. This test was disguised, according to Rosenthal, as a test that could predict whether or not a child would bloom intellectually. About 20 percent of the children in the study were chosen randomly. The teachers of these children were told that according to their test scores these children were about to undergo an intellectual growth spurt and make surprising gains over the next eight months. There was no difference in the children from the experimental group and the control group—except what their teachers thought about them. Finally at the end of the school year, the children were retested. Rosenthal says he found that the children who were in the experimental group, where false high expectations had been planted in their teachers' minds, showed significantly greater gain than the control group.

To reduce your risk of colon cancer, cut back on red and processed meats



Association, if you want to reduce the likeli-hood that you will develop colon cancer, you should eat less red and processed meats (like sausage, hot dogs and the like). The study indicates that people who fre—quently eat these meats have 30 percent to 50 percent higher chances of developing colon cancer. While meat itself may contain cancer-causing properties, cooking meats at high temperatures can also make them more carcinogenic. To reduce your risk cut back on red and processed meats and eat only fresh lean cuts when you indulge. High temperature cooking, such as grilling/charbroiling and frying should be avoided.

So just what are trans fats anyway?

Then you go shopping these days it's likely that you're going to see lots of items claiming they are low in or have no trans fats. Just what are trans fats? Trans fatty acids are made by heating liquid vegetable oils in the presence of hydrogen, according to the Harvard School of Public Health. The process is more commonly known as



hydrogenation. It's easy to figure out how hydrogenated an oil is—the harder the oil will be at room temperature the more hydrogenated it will be. So if you go into the store and you have a choice between stick margarine and a soft and spreadable margarine, you know the spreadable one is less hydrogenated, and therefore contains less trans fats.

As you have probably guessed processed foods often contain more trans fats. Snack foods and pre-pared baked foods and french fries and other fried snacks usually have a lot of trans fats. Trans fats are not good for your cholesterol level because they raise the level of bad LDL (low-density lipoproteins, which carry cholesterol from the liver into the rest of the body, and when there's too much of it, it can be deposited on the walls of the arteries) and lower the level of good HDL (high-density lipoproteins, which carry blood back to the liver and processes cholesterol so that it can be eliminated from the system).

lease read the following memo:
Sickness and related leave: We will no longer accept a doctor's statement as proof of sickness. If you are able to go to the doctor, you are able to come to work.



- **Surgery:** Operations are now banned. As long as you are an employee here, you need all your organs. You should not consider removing anything. We hired you intact. To have something removed constitutes a breach of employment.
- **Bereavement leave:** This is no excuse for missing work. There is nothing you can do for dead friends, relatives or coworkers. Every effort should be made to have nonemployees attend to the arrangements. In rare cases, where employee involvement is necessary, the funeral should be scheduled in the late afternoon. 


