Thank you to those that attended the November HOA meeting. For those who couldn't make it, below are the results with the negotiations with management regarding the lot increase.

1. The pool heater will be turned on based on temperature as opposed to a set date additional money will be added to the budget for the added electricity.
2. The bad trees will all be removed throughout the community
 - a. I presented a list of all those trees to William and it was accepted
3. Bob Waldorf and William will work together in contacting the City of St. Petersburg to resolve the cleaning of the ditch problem. If necessary, John mentioned getting their legal team involved.
4. The water issues in the park are being worked on but will take time and resources.
5. Storm drains will be cleaned on a regular schedule which will assist in the drain-off issues we have been experiencing.
6. A closer look will be taken at the washout between 1st Lane and Way.
7. All electrical posts throughout the community will be maintained
8. The fence around the front pond will be taken down and the edges secured by rocks. John did agree to leave the patch of grass closest to 102nd Terrace clear of rocks so the swans will be able to get to the grass
9. More speed limit signs will be added throughout the park
 - a. John has no issue with the "Slow Down" signs currently being posted by some residents
10. It was agreed that the increase in lot rent will be taken from \$44.00 to \$39.00.

Nomination for 2 Board Seats:

1. Nominations should include Your Name, a brief bio of who you are and why you want to be on the board. It lets people know who you are.
2. All nominations to be included on the ballot need to be submitted to a board member prior to December 1st.

The Annual Meeting and Election will take place on Wednesday, December 14th. See you then.

When you come for dinner please bring your own place setting and your side dish and arrive by 1:15 PM. We will eat promptly at 1:30.

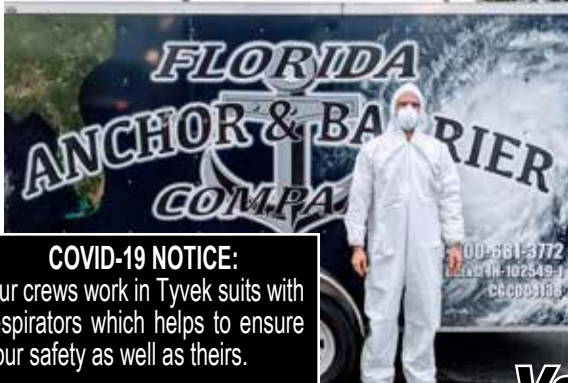
The Gateway Christmas Dinner will follow a format quite similar to Thanksgiving.

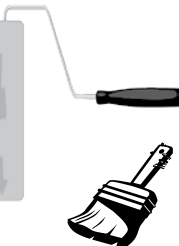

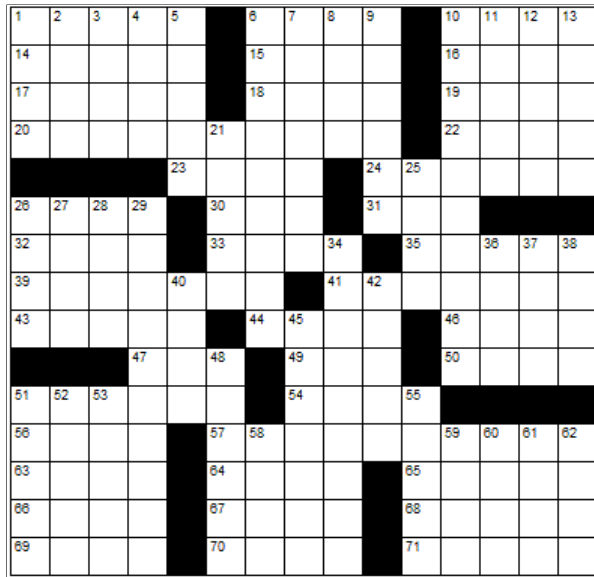
