

As many are aware, we have been addressing water pipes that are breaking. Having learned that neighboring parks are also experiencing the same issue, we are working with Pinellas County to determine the issue and get this resolved. A question that often comes up is regarding leaks in or under the home and whose responsibility it may be. According to the Eldorado Village Prospectus: The Park is responsible for the maintenance of the underground water and sewer systems from the point where such systems connect to the lines owned by Pinellas County Water & Sewer to the point where such systems rise above ground level at each mobile home lot. The mobile home owner is responsible for the maintenance of the water and sewer connections from the mobile home to the riser.

For those of you who wish to have an electronic version of the Prospectus in which you can easily search for terms to help clarify any questions you may have, please let us know. We are governed by Chapter 723 of the

Florida Statutes and this document provides a description of the property, outlines our relationship and addresses the rules and regulations. You can email us at EastBayOaks@ EquityLifestyle.com to request a copy of the PDF.

HOA NEWS

t is no surprise to any of us that the amounts of our bills are going up. But it was a surprise to the HOA when we got our insurance bill. We carry Commercial General Liability Insurance and last year we paid \$600+ for that policy. This year our bill, minus early payment discount, is \$1114.86. Almost double the amount.

At \$10.00 per home dues that means that we need at least 110 people to pay their dues. The past several years we have not even come close to having 100 people paying dues. Our other absolute bill is \$65 to the State of Florida each year to register our HOA.

I am sure that you will step up and pay the \$10.00 so that you have voting rights at our meetings. You may contact any of our board members, listed in the Media, pay at coffee on Tuesdays, or stop in at Dorisanne Gibson's home at lot 187.

Speaking of meetings, please mark your calendars now for HOA meetings. They are open to all homeowners in the park whether you have paid your dues or not. The meetings are not open to renters.

Smoking and Drinking at the Pool

Do You Want To Be In the Know?

oving forward, all bulk communications, announcements, updates, etc from the Management Office to the Residents will be made via our bulk Texting system called Text-Em-All. We already have several people sign up, but we want everyone signed so that you never miss any important information about your community. If you have not already been receiving text updates from us, please contact the office right away so we can get you signed up. This only works with a cell phone, however, but I do believe that most people have those these days but if you do not, you could ask a neighbor to be your communications buddy and let you know anytime an update text comes through. If nothing else, let us know you do not have a cell phone here at the office and we will work with you on an alternative so that you stay informed.

Pet Policy

few things about pets I want to point out so there are no questions about your responsibility as a pet owner. Keeping a pet on the property is a privilege and not a right and as such, the following rules must be adhered to or we will have no choice but to ask you to remove the animal from the property. These rules apply whether the animal is a household pet, an Emotional Support Animal, or a Service Animal.

- 1. ALL animals must be registered with the office, and we will need all required documentation for any ESA's or Service Animals.
- 2. Dogs are to be on leashes AT ALL TIMES and the handler must maintain control of their animal at all times, not letting it run up or jump on people or other animals.
- 3. Pet cats are supposed to be indoor animals only.
- 4. You MUST pick up after your pet goes to the bathroom–we do have doggy pots at both properties that have the bags and a container just for that.
- 5. Excessive barking must be controlled so the pet is not bothering the neighbors. I seem to hear this a lot and it is against park rules.



The Eldorado Village Social Club has been supporting the work of RCS for more than 8 years! The first records are from our former neighbor, Shirley Pratt, followed by John Campbell and Michelle Leamon and, currently, Sandy Yost–all delivering our club donations to RCS. Individuals and families may access services once a month, receiving 3-4 days' worth of food for all household members per visit. A photo ID, SS card and a piece of mail with current address are needed. If you or someone you know need a ride to RCS, please contact Debbie and Steve Ennis or Sandy Yost.

RCS programs and services include:

RCS Food Banks serve 70,000 Pinellas County neighbors–32,000 of these neighbors are senior citizens and children. Over 4 million pounds of food are distributed annually with support from nearly 100 other local food banks and pantries.

RCS Grace House helps individuals and families facing homelessness return to self-sufficiency.

The Haven of RCS provides safety, security and support for women and children facing domestic abuse. Their outreach center serves nearly 17,000 women and children annually. Their safe house sheltered over 300 women and children last year and they provide a resource list for men needing assistance with domestic violence issues. Their hotline receives over 4,000 calls annually with requests for assistance in matters of domestic violence.

Goldsmith Gardens provides comfortable, safe, affordable housing and support for individuals and families. Their housing community serves 12 families and nearly 40 individuals annually. They provide wrap-around programs and services that are conducive to self-sufficiency– including education, financial literacy, workforce development and life skill development.

Basic Needs are met through a variety of collaborations and partnerships.

Information About Water Shutoffs:

s most residents know, there are times that the water in Eldorado must be turned off to make repairs. There is nothing we can do about that, but there are some things that we can do to avoid trouble.



We have adopted a new system to notify residents in the event water is turned off. This system will generate a phone call to the residents alerting them to the fact that the water is off or will be shortly. If you are not sure if your name is on the park's robocall list, I would suggest that you check with the office to make sure you are on the list or added.

We suggest that you turn off your hot water heater if you are concerned about it. Also, when you want to check if the water has come back on, use the cold water for this purpose to not let air into your hot water heater. You can also turn off the water coming into your home which will prevent water from draining out of it and into the sewer system. Some folks keep a few gallons of water on hand just for such emergencies.

PLEASE DO NOT CALL THE OFFICE TO ASK ABOUT THE WATER SHUTOFFS!






