Additionally, feeding wildlife invites other animals into the area such as coyotes, raccoons, and bats which in turn increases the potential for rabies or creating a predatory environment for smaller animals. All pets are to be fed <u>inside</u> your home, not outside, and we ask that everyone refrain from feeding any other animal that is not your own. Further, although bird feeders are not prohibited in the community, it does attract other animals that may not be welcome. Please reference the Prospectus with regard to pets. Pets are not allowed to roam free or be left unattended when leashed.
