ompliance: The Board has received several complaints about overnight parking in the streets and cars parked blocking the sidewalks. Overnight parking on the streets and cars or golf carts blocking the sidewalks is

against the Rules and Regulations of the park. An email blast was sent out to remind residents regarding this violation. Repeat offenders are subject to fines or towing.

The Board has received complaints about residents leaving the water running in the pool showers. This wastes water and runs up our park expenses. If the intent is to wait for hot water, please stay in the shower area and do not leave the water running any more than needed.

Please turn off the lights to the bathrooms when you leave. Every little bit helps with our electric bills.

Maintenance:

- A new television was installed in the hall replacing the one damaged in a lightning storm.
- Fencing damaged by hurricane Ian was repaired.
- A pool circulating pump will have to be replaced.
- The Board will be replacing all palms with Foxtail palms in the future. These palms are self-pruning and should help with our tree trimming expenses.
- The weeds in the lake were sprayed along the lake front as well as in the cove. This was done as a one-time action to help with the weed control in the lake. The county also sprayed the weeds along the lake front.
- The park tractor required a new hydraulic cylinder for the power steering. This took the equipment out of service for about two weeks and was an unexpected expense.
- The floor in the hall is scheduled to be stripped and rewaxed in November.
- Additional erosion was found and repaired along the boardwalk.

Rules and Regulations: Proposed changes to the Rules and Regulations accompany this report. These proposed changes are also available in the hall and in the office. The changes are marked in yellow. Potential New Internet Provider: The Board is in discussions with WOW, an internet service provider, to install an infrastructure that would support an alternative to the existing ISP providers. This infrastructure will be installed at no cost to the park. The Board expects WOW to contact residents to determine interest in the new service. Residents are not obligated to use the new service. This is an option for our residents. WOW is installed in several parks in the area and has come with good reviews.

Email Blasts: In order to ensure each shareholder is getting the latest information from the park, please make sure you are registered with the office to receive email blasts and receive voting information via email.

Financial Status:

- Financial information for October is posted in the hall.
- The financial workshop is scheduled for 12 December in the hall immediately following coffee. A sign-up sheet will be posted for all interested in attending.
- Like our residents, the park is experiencing inflationary effects. The cost of our supplies have increased this year and the Board is being warned of expected increases in insurance, mowing, service contracts, and maintenance item. The Board is closely monitoring expenses.

Reserve Usage: In the current year budget, the Board anticipated using \$59K in reserve funding to replace and maintain high expense items. This year the following items have been repaired or replaced using reserve funding:

Two symbiont heaters.	Cost: \$22,268
• Piping and filter replacement for pool room.	Cost: \$12,165
Pool chemical controller.	Cost: \$2461
• SPA chemical controller.	Cost: \$2461
• Toilet replacement in hall and pool area.	Cost: \$9953
• Hall roof repair to bring under warranty.	Cost: \$3000
• Electrical repair of pool room wiring.	Cost: \$4825
• Electrical repair of shuffleboard courts and outside circuits.	Cost: \$4966
Total Reserve Use	\$62,099

These repairs and maintenance items were necessary to maintain our facilities. The reserves allowed the Board to pay for these items without the use of assessments.

Board Meeting: Next board meeting is scheduled for 7 November 2022 after coffee. The meeting will be in person in the hall and via Zoom. An invitation will be sent to all shareholder via email.
