ecember is upon us. By now you have received the letter from Teakwood Village about lot rent increase. Some things I noticed while preparing the envelopes for mailing. First thing I noticed is that there are a few people who I am pretty sure have made a permanent move to Teakwood, but I still have an address outside Teakwood for them. When you make the permanent move and sell your home outside Teakwood, I need that info in writing so that I can keep our files updated.

Second thing is that many of you have lost a partner or roommate and our paperwork still has the both of you on it. Again, I need this info in writing. If someone moves out, just have them write me a note saying they no longer live there, have no interest in living there and sign and date it. Easy peasy. If someone has died, I need a death certificate to remove their name from the records. Remember if I don't receive this paperwork and someone moves in with you, you will be charged (per the Rules and Regulations) for having 3 people in the home.

Third thing is hearing a rumor that a home was sold privately, but I have no info on the buyer, so the seller is still on the lease with Teakwood. So, if you purchased your home, not from Teakwood Village Sales, please make sure to check with the Sales office (727-581-2628) and take care of the paperwork so we can communicate with you.

I said to put in writing the information (phone numbers, who is no longer in home, addresses outside Teakwood or change to Teakwood only, emergency contact, etc) you can email this info to twwdllf@aol.com, just identify yourself and your Teakwood address, by text to 727-584-8684 and identify yourself in the text so I know who you are or drop a note in the drop box here at the main office.

Enjoy all the holidays this month and have a pear to celebrate Nat'l Pear Month. Talk again next year when we will cover, not sure just yet, but I'm working on it.

ost of us have a wee bit o' Irish, so, we were excited to be going to Four Green Fields Irish Pub in Tampa for lunch. The info said it was in an authentic thatched roof Irish Pub, some

As it turned out our group ended up at the "other" Four Green Fields in Tampa at 201 Platt Street which was difficult to get to due to all the construction going on around Channelside.

The waitress informed us our group would be comped a free drink and soda bread as an interviewer and crew was filming a couple who wrote a book, just out online that day BENGHAZI, KNOW THY ENEMY.

Everyone but me had the Guiness stew. Marty said, "It's not worth it." The stew was \$18.00 and while the other four did not mention the price, nor the black plastic dish, they liked it, but it was obvious it was a disappointment as was the f soda bread which as you may know is bland. I had the pretzels (\$7.00) which were warm, salty and buttery. There was no beer cheese or gravy, but they did have honey mustard for dipping. While the pretzel did not have the nice presentation of Miller's and O'Keefes it was tasty. My Farmer's Lunch also \$7.00 consisted of two small slices of soda bread with partially melted butter so you could either spread it on the bread or dip it, small sweet purple grapes, a thinly sliced hard-boiled egg and sharp cheddar cheese. Two men had light Irish beer, brewed on site, which they liked, and I tried a Jameson whiskey with seven up. The watered-down version was more to my liking as I do not prefer whiskey. 



There are always opportunities for volunteering at the physical location of Hope Villages. There are some great folks I have met in my volunteering there and always looked forward to helping them in their efforts.



FROM DEE'S KITCHEN TO YOURS

-Dee Potenti

VEGETABLE PIZZA

2 pkg-8 oz cream cheese softened

½ C mayo

1-pkg ranch dry mix

2 cans Pillsberry crescent rolls

1- red pepper chopped fine

1- yellow pepper chopped fine

1- orange pepper chopped fine

1-red onion chopped baby fine

1- can black olives chopped

1-1/2 C shredded Mexican cheese



Beat cream cheese, mayo, and dry ranch dressing mix until smooth. Set aside.

Preheat oven 350 degrees

Remove crescent rolls from the cans and roll out in one big piece onto a large, greased cookie sheet. Pinch seams together, if needed. Bake for 8-10 minutes or until golden brown. Let cool completely.

When cool, spread the cream cheese mixture on top. Then layer all your chopped vegetables, starting with your red onion on the bottom because that's the strongest, then peppers and black olives. You can also add any vegetable that you'd like. Top with shredded Mexican cheese. Cut with a pizza cutter into squares. Serve right away or refrigerate and cover well. Enjoy!

EASY CHRISTMAS HOR D'OEUVRE

2- Pears (Bartlett or Bosc)

Cut into 8 wedges

2 tsp fresh lemon juice

1-C arugula

3 oz. blue cheese cut into small pieces

6 oz. thinly sliced prosciutto- cut in half length wise

In large bowl toss the pears with lemon juice

Lay a slice of pear, an arugula leaf, and a piece of blue cheese on a piece of prosciutto, then roll it up. Delightful!
