I Serendipity Residents!
My name is Marty Ott and I live at #340 on India. I have been appointed the "Neighborhood Watch Liaison" for Serendipity MHP by the HOA and Pinellas County Sheriff's Department. My responsibility in this position is to take calls from the residents of Serendipity and give weekly feedback to the park manager and the PCSO Neighborhood Watch Commander, Deputy Chuck Skipper.

November 2022 Notes:

Fortunately, there were no phone calls for the month of November although I have been in communication with Deputy Skipper several times.

Just a reminder if you see something dangerous or feel threatened, call **911.** If it is just to report something suspicious, call the Sheriff's non-emergency number at (727) 582-6200. Then call me the next morning at (727) 787-3272 and I will note it in the daily log so that we can categorize the types of problems we are having, and the Sheriff can assign manpower to our park at times and places necessary.

Serendipity residents should **ONLY CALL** me during regular business hours which are 8:00AM - 5:00PM.





- 1 cake mix yellow or white
- (Mix and bake according to instructions in a 9x13 inch pan).
- Allow cake to cool.
- 1-5.1 oz large box of vanilla instant pudding (prepare according to instructions)
- 1-8oz pkg of cream cheese
- (Cut into small pieces and mix into pudding. Spread mixture on top of cooled cake)
- 1-20 oz can crushed pineapple (Drain & spread pineapple on top of pudding mixture)
- 1-8 oz container of thawed Cool Whip (Spread on top of pineapple)
 Sprinkle shredded coconuts or chopped nuts on top and then top with Maraschino cherries.
