

Manager's Corner – January 2023

appy New Year! We hope that everyone had a wonderful holidav season. Hard to believe it is 2023 already!!

One of the most difficult areas to manage is the dumpster area. MAN We want to ensure that this area remains manageable and ask that you communicate to your hired handymen or contractors that they are not allowed to use the dumpsters for construction debris. Dumpsters are for residents' use for household trash and homeowners' "minor" construction debris (i.e., rolled up carpeting, broken down drywall, etc.). Large bulky items such as appliances and furniture are not allowed in the dumpster area. Please arrange to have large bulky items removed to a dumpsite off property. When the dumpsters get overfilled, the area must be closed and our maintenance team has to divert their attention to cleaning it up so the dumpsters can be pulled. This is outside of their allocated scope of work and it creates an inconvenience for the residents in both parks when access is limited.

Again, anyone you hire and pay, such as a handyman service or company, must haul the debris off property, and use their own dumpsters. External use of the dumpsters is considered a theft of service and they are committing a felony.

Aside from that, we hope that the coming months ahead are filled with joy and abundant laughter.

Please Don't Poison The Animals

o one wants an uninvited critter to make themselves at home, but poisoning has unintended consequences. When we had to pull a dead opossum from under our floor, and she had a poison pellet



clenched in her jaws. Besides being an extremely cruel method of killing (animals suffer violent seizures and excruciating pain for extended periods of time while their lungs flood, eventually suffocating them) dying animals will find a dark, dry place - like the underside of your house - to die and decompose. The stench is overwhelming.

Innumerable "non-targeted" animals can also suffer and die after consuming animals who have eaten poison. Birds in particular die in droves after eating mice and rats who have eaten poison. So please, if you think someone is trying to move in, borrow a live trap (there are several folks willing to loan theirs, ask me), or buy an inexpensive live trap from the hardware store for smaller critters (Have-A-Heart is a good one) and not only save a life, but save yourself a very unpleasant task. Some cheap deterrents:Cut up bars of Irish Spring soap around the perimiter of your house, and/or cotton-soaked peppermint (Aldi's has cheap, strong peppermint in the baking aisle.) Scattered moth balls (use sparingly) help, but do so only if you're a snowbird and up North - they really stink!

On a related note: If you spot a snake near your coach, consider yourself very lucky! Snakes will keep all rodents far away from your place. Please do not kill snakes and try to get over your fear - they want to avoid you at all costs.

We're in Florida - let's live in harmony with wildlife.


