MESSAGE FROM THE ROC PRESIDENT Ron Kelly Lot #413

t is hard to believe that 2022 is already at an end, and we welcome 2023! The Four Seasons Board of Directors wishes all our residents and their families, a healthy, happy and prosperous New Year!

In the coming year, we expect the sale of the shares of Four Seasons Estates to be completed with Legacy, who will then manage the park, as the Board of Directors will dissolve after the ROC has officially ceased closing the books for Four Seasons Estates. The day-to-day management of the park will revert to Legacy and their management team on the day of closing.

Also, the Restore utility upgrade program will start to be implemented and the reconstruction of both the sewer and wastewater lines will become much more apparent.

Since my last letter in the park newsletter, we have finally had the pool light repaired, so normal swimming hours will return from dawn till 10:00 pm. This means no one in the pool area after 10:00 pm. Please be respectful of other residents in the pool, especially with language and the volume of radios or Bluetooth speakers being obnoxiously loud. As always, no glass of any kind is allowed in the pool area.

Please remember there is no overnight parking permitted on Four Seasons roadways. We have a contract with the towing company, and it includes unannounced sweeps of our streets after 11:00 pm. Illegally parked vehicles will be towed, and the owner will not only be responsible for the towing fee, but also a storage fee. If you need somewhere to temporarily park a vehicle, go to the office and request a pass to park your vehicle on the gravel lot next to the clubhouse. This pass must then be displayed on the dashboard of your vehicle.

In closing, thanks to all our residents for your cooperation and patience over the past year. We sincerely believe that 2023 will be a great year for Four Seasons Estates ROC Inc.

THE FEDERATION OF MANUFACTURED HOMEOWNERS OF FLORIDA, INC. FMO-----DID YOU READ?

When you purchased a unit in your park, did you read your prospectus? If so, did you understand it? Did you realize the full extent to which it controls items that relate to maintenance, repair or replacement responsibility to either the homeowner or the park owner?

These are all questions that you may wish you understood more fully as a new coach owner. In 2002-03, when I purchased my unit, I didn't even know the word. I was told that the

prospectus should be in your unit, that it pertains to your unit only, and that you are to leave it



in the unit should you sell it. I signed my lease and was told to enjoy Four Seasons.

Twenty years later, I view it in the same category as homeowner insurance or medical insurance policies, where a clear understanding takes a third party to help you. One tends to skim, reading over the paragraphs and never fully understanding them until we have an issue.

Now is when being an FMO member benefits you. It has multiple avenues that provides you explanations and oversees if your park owners are adhering to the Florida Statue 723 as it relates to mobile homes and manufactured home parks. They have a legal department to contact and legalese groups that often offer pro bono assistance.
