n the corner of 39th Ave N. & 4th Street sits a new Fifth Third Bank. Next door they are building a new Starbucks that will be open within the next 3 months. But here is what you didn't know.

Sometime in 1995 Durango Steak House open a 5000 square foot restaurant on that piece of land. The restaurant was very popular and visited by both locals and snow birds until it closed in 2009. The once popular eatery had a terrible ending.

On December 11th, 2005 assistant manager Stephen Holms, 29, was found stabbed to death inside the restaurant. His killer was Wilson Sainti, 51, who worked in the restaurant as a maintenance person. Business dropped off after the killing and the restaurant finally closed in 2009. The restaurant turned into an eye sore until the city issues a permit to tear in down in 2019.

It is now the new home for a new Fifth Third Bank and soon to open Starbucks.
