VICE PRESIDENT ANNOUNCEMENT

ello my fellow neighbors. I would like to inform everyone on how the Nomination of Officers is conducted.

- Please review the following:
 A nominating committee shall be formed in January r
- A nominating committee shall be formed in January prior to the Annual meeting held in February.
- The nominating committee chairperson shall be appointed by the Vice President, the chairperson shall then select 3 or 5 members of the HOA membership.
- The members chosen must be in good standings and not running for an Executive office.
- The committee shall not exceed more than five (5) members total (excluding the chairperson).
- The committee must construct and post a list of all the Executive Offices on a standard piece of paper with enough ample room to the right side of each title for the members who wish to place their names for that office. An eligibility form shall be filled out.
- The list must be posted in a common place (Clubhouse) known to all membership in ample time prior to the Annual meeting in February.
- No candidate may run for more than one (1) position.
- No one can print the name of any other member for any office with or without consent.
- Nominations at the Annual February meeting may be taken off the floor providing the member is present and accepts the nomination.
- Eligible candidates must be Property Owners/Lease Holders and of enough age as described per office prior to the election.
- Only one (1) candidate per Mobile (dual ownership) shall be allowed on the ballot for any position.
- The committee must be present at the Annual February meeting and the meeting for elections in March.
- A nominee may remove his/her name after the closing provided the following are met; must present a signed letter in writing or print to any nominating committee chairperson prior to the election.
- Campaigning is allowed and limited to only social activities or events held by the HOA membership. The use of propaganda however shall not be used for campaigning.
- Slandering, defacing, or any inappropriate conduct toward your opponent will not be tolerated and can/will have you removed from the nominations.
- When the Annual February meeting adjourns, all nominations will be closed. Any questions, please let me know. Thank you

Go ahead, be an optimist

A few packing dos and don't for the frequent traveler

When you actually put your clothes into your suitcase here's a good regimen to follow. Put your underclothes in first.
