We are having a problem with dogs being outside and not on a leash; park rules state that all dogs must be on a leash with a human being on the other end of the leash, they are not to be tied up! Dogs are not to be walked in the park except for a registered service dog (which does NOT include emotional support dogs). We currently only have 3 actual service dogs in the park. All dogs must be registered in the office, and if you are not in the pet section you need to have the proper paperwork to show why you qualify for an exception. If you see a dog issue, please report it to the office....the only way I know if someone has a dog that isn't properly registered is with the help of the residents.

Mail-do not park in front of your (or your neighbor's!) mailbox or you may not get your mail. They are not required on a driving route to get out of their vehicle simply because they cannot get to your mailbox. As most of you know, we have had a hard time keeping a regular mailman on our route; we now have one, so show some courtesy by not blocking your mailbox. Another

problem is that you are not making sure your lot number is in your address CORRECTLY when you give it out---it should be a third line in the address because a lot of automated systems have a limit of how many characters are allowed per line, so when you put it down like this, 16416 US Highway 19 N, Lot 1800 there is a good chance that part of the lot information is cut off. The correct way is: 1st line name; 2nd line 16416 US Highway 19 N; 3rd line Lot number; 4th line Clearwater, FL 33764. When your mail is not addressed properly you run the risk of it being "returned to sender". This method of addressing should also be used when you are ordering from a company to make sure you get your items.

Messy carports and backyards are a continuing problem; if you receive 2 letters from the office within a year it is grounds for eviction! The best all of the carports ever looked was when we had to prepare for Hurricane Ian----that should be the normal way to maintain your carports—no refrigerators unless they are locked, no indoor furniture, no ladders that are not attached to the carport or mobile, no garbage cans outside (keep them in your shed), no building materials unless you are in the middle of a project and actively working on it, etc. Backyards should also be maintained free of all clutter so that they can be mowed. Having a fenced in yard does not mean that you can pile it full of junk—same rules apply—no garbage, no indoor furniture, no building materials, etc.

Just a reminder that rent goes up \$30 for all mobile homes as of Jan. 1, 2023. I am repeating this as we still received checks wrote in colored ink: *the bank will no longer be accepting any checks unless they are made out using Blue or Black Ink.* Any checks made out by pencil, markers, highlighters, and colored ink will be rejected by the office. You will be contacted to provide a new check, which means your rent may be considered late because you did not provide the office with a cashable check.

To all Park residents----I don't mean to be a Grinch, however....to those of you who are placing Christmas lights/decorations in your yards, would you please avoid anything that has Red or blue flashing lights together!!! Every time I come around the corner, I think it's the police. I have to brake hard, toss my beer out the window, fasten my seat belt, throw my phone on the floor, and turn my radio down, all while trying to drive! It's just too much drama, even for Christmas. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding.
