





Alcohol in Pool Area

Please remember that no glass of any kind is allowed around the pool area. We are getting reports of beer bottles around the pool. If glass is broken in the pool, it can be quite expensive to clean out.



Please remember there is NO alcohol in the pool area, in the pool or hot tub.

The Hot Tub is for Adults Only

To one under 18 is permitted in the Hot Tub. Food and drink, of any kind, are not allowed in the pool or hot tub. The hot tub is meant for short sessions only, no longer than 15 minutes. The use of alcohol combined with the relaxing heat of the hot tub can be a dangerous combination. A person can easily slip under the water unnoticed, and tragedy can strike quickly. Never swim alone. Use the buddy system for safety.

Also, for the health and wellbeing of everyone, please do not go in the hot tub or pool if you are not feeling well, have wounds or open sores.

dditional guests staying overnight in the park must be registered and paid for. Cost is \$9 per person per night, \$55 per person per week and \$180 per person per month.



Residents must accompany their guests while at the pool or other locations and are responsible for the behavior of their guests. Children under 18 must be accompanied by an adult who shall assume full responsibility for their safety and conduct.


