

#### **LINCOLNSHIRE HISTORY:**

By: the "new - old timers"

......Continued - - 
s we continue to remember the history of Lincolnshire, this month we visit "Largo ...

The Town"

It's June6th 1905, and seven years before Pinellas County was formed out of Hillsborough County and the "Town of Largo" was incorporated and came into being by an act of the state legislature. The town was ¾ mile X ¾ mile. The boundaries were 4th Ave. to the south, Taylor Ave. to the north, Clearwater Road to the west, and 4th St. NE to the east. Bay Drive ran through the middle, and Missouri and Seminole were not connected as they are now. Not at all a large area as it is today

Women were not permitted on the streets without an escort after 9 PM, and auto drivers were fined \$5 (high in those days) and given 3 days in jail for exceeding the speed limit of **8 MPH**. (OK Lincolnshire – our current park speed is higher than the legal speed on the roads back then – quit complaining about needing to go slow) Largo was small, but ready to grow and by 1913 a bill was passed to abolish the government of the town of Largo under the old system and establish a commission form of government with a town manager. Progressive for the day.

Largo became one of the first towns in Florida to operate under a city manager, - the second in the United States to adopt a commission/manager and, as far as we could learn, it was the smallest town in the world to take this step with an area only <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of a square mile.

#### **AVOID FLORIDA PROBATE COURT**



#### **Baked Sweet and Sour Chicken**

#### **Ingredients**

4 boneless skinless chicken breasts, cut into 1" pieces

1 cup corn starch

2 large eggs

1/4 cup vegetable oil

1/2 cup granulated sugar

1/4 cup ketchup

1/2 cup apple cider vinegar

2 tbsp. soy sauce

1 tsp. garlic powder

1/2 tsp. sea salt

Directions

Preheat oven to 325F and line a 13 x 9-inch pan with parchment paper.

Set aside. Season chicken breasts with salt and pepper.

Add cornstarch to a large ziploc bag and add chicken breast. Shake to coat.

In a shallow bowl, beat together eggs. Heat oil in a skillet over medium-high heat until sizzling.

Dip chicken breasts in eggs and add to the skillet. Sear chicken until golden and place in the prepared pan.

In a medium bowl, combine sugar, ketchup, vinegar, soy sauce, garlic powder, and sea salt and whisk.

Pour over chicken and bake for 1 hour, tossing halfway through.

Serve with rice.



#### **VETERAN'S CORNER**

**Teterans Crisis Line - The holidays are here and with now over 44 Veterans a day committing suicide!** If you are in a crisis—or are concerned about someone else in crisis—get free, confidential support 24 hours a day, seven days a week. The Veterans Crisis Line is available by phone, text or chat: Dial 988, then Press 1, Send a text to 838255, Support for deaf and hard of hearing: Call 1-800-799-4889.

All U.S. veterans and Gold Star family members will be able to get a free lifetime entrance pass for federal parks and recreation sites nationwide starting Nov. 11. The pass grants free access to about 2,000 parks and lands managed by the National Park Service. It also gives discounted amenity fees in some locations.

While not every park or visitor area requires an entrance fee, many do. For example, Yosemite National Park in California charges a \$35 entrance fee per vehicle, while Craters of the Moon National Monument charges \$20. Other locations charge for entering museum or curation areas in the visitor center. For instance, the Begich, Boggs Visitor Center in the Chugach National Forest, Alaska, charges \$5 per adult to access a film and exhibits.

Those fees are waived for holders of the new lifetime pass, as well as those with the free active-duty America the Beautiful military pass or other passes. The new pass covers the holder and any accompanying passengers in a private vehicle at sites that charge per car, or the pass owners and up to three adults age 16 and over at sites that charge per person.

The new lifetime pass program does not exclude veterans with so-called "bad paper" discharges. To get the pass, veterans must submit one of the following:

- Unexpired Department of Defense Identification Card (DD Form 2, DD Form 2765, or Next Generation USID replacement)
- Veteran Health Identification Card (VHIC)
- Veteran ID Card
- Veteran designation on a state-issued U.S. driver's license or identification card

To receive a pass visit a National Parks or parks and land agency store or staffed fee kiosk, or order via the <u>U.S. Geological Survey store</u>. Passes ordered online carry a \$10 processing and shipping fee. Passes received in-person are free.

#### A Nurse's Self Care Toolbox #56

ontact me if there is a subject you want me to bring forward that impacts our Park residents.

Last month, December, I started a 3-month series on nutrition, movement (exercise) and finally on both pre-diabetes and diabetes. With so many new homeowners in Lincolnshire Estates, I simply wanted to run this series again. If you have read it before I would suggest spending a few minutes to read again. Diabetes remains a significant issue for over 55 year old's. This month is about how we get everything from what we swallow (or should swallow) for energy. Energy is the goal for every one of our cells including fat so they can do their job, whatever it is. Nerve cells to conduct information, muscle cells to flex and contract, skin cells to mature and replace what just fell off us and the list goes on. Even fat cells that just sit there and little if anything except if there is famine (or if our diabetes is really out of control.)

99% of everything we swallow turns to sugar! Unless you are into corn husks. The better question is how fast. Almost pure sugar like candy, cookies, pies (you get the drift here) are broken down in the stomach and small intestine. Then absorbed into our blood in less than 10 minutes or even seconds. Yikes! Fruits especially grapes, oranges are just like pure sugar. Starches like pasta, white bread, potatoes take just a bit longer like 20 minutes. Whole grains in some breads and cereals take about 40 minutes (This is not Sugar Frosted Flakes!) Vegetables (greens) take up to 45 minutes to get into our blood. Oh, corn is not a vegetable, sorry. Meat (animal, fish, and poultry) are very dense food and take from 45-60 minutes to get broken down into sugar and absorbed. When we eat combination foods like a casserole each food will take its own time to be converted to sugar. The term "blanced meal" essentially means a meal that has all the food groups and in total takes almost an hour to be completely broken down in to sugar and absorbed in the blood. Hence the term "blood sugar."

Sugars are absorbed starting in our stomach and all the way down our small intestine. We start preparing the food for conversion in to sugar in our mouths by chewing and saliva production. Did you know that we start making saliva when we even think of food? Chewing our food is a big deal! We are a human blender. Keeping our teeth or always using dentures is key to better digestion.

Our stomach further treats our food and the small intestine completes the job of breaking almost all we eat into sugar. Vitamins and minerals are also absorbed if and only if in their basic form. Sugar from our food races (I mean races) through the lining of our gut into many small blood vessels. The sugar attaches to red blood cells (why our A1C levels are taken from our blood) and floats freely in the blood circulating to every cell in our body. Every single one! Even our fat cells are living. Our cells are waiting for fresh sugar. I will talk about what happens when our cells don't get "fresh sugar" every 3-4 hours next month.

So how does the sugar get from the blood into the cell to make energy? Insulin (a hormone and a truly lifesaving big deal!) Insulin propels the sugar into each living cell 24/7/365 days. Even in Leap Years. More on insulin next month too. Chew, walk and ride well my friends. Eat and then move soon. We can do this!


