
It is unbelievable that a year has passed by so quickly. It has been enjoyable serving as your president. It has been a learning experience throughout the year. We have an amazing staff; Pat Merl, David Helms, Sue Goodring, and Harvey Shaw. All of them place the park first, work above expectations to make Holiday Shores an exceptional place to reside.

As I reflect on last year I have seen many changes. We needed to complete the unfinished projects from the preceding year; new door on clubhouse, remodel of clubhouse, and termite eradication. As many of you know the door frame was rotted and so was the wood under the frame.

My next experience was with the insurers of the park. Our previous company had insured the condo that collapsed in Miami. We were fortunate to get another underwriter. With this came an inspector that required us to update and replace many things throughout the park. Some include; swimming pool lighting is required by the state of Florida for nightly use. The awning on the back of the maintenance shed was falling off, and the electrical panel in the maintenance shed did not meet code requirements for the insurance industry.

A Reserve study is done on regular basis to determine the longevity of items in the park. We base our budget around this study. The air conditioners were replaced in the clubhouse as they were not working. Unfortunately, the pool heater was to have two more years of life, but it failed, hence replacement.

Many of you had questions about the ballot and the term "full funding of reserves". We put away monies to fund projects and maintenance for the upcoming years. We are not fully funding our reserves at this point in time. The State of Florida is requiring full funding for any buildings that are three stories or higher and within three miles of water in the upcoming year. This will eventually go to two story structures, then one story structures. At a recent conference we learned that insurance companies may require all HOA's and cooperatives to do this much quicker. Failure to do so will be lack of insurance coverage. It is imperative that we maintain our structures and facilities as needed. We all know if you let something go in your home or vehicle that eventually the repair or replacement will be much higher. It has been our philosophy to maintain to the best of our ability. Currently there are only three insurers in the state of Florida that provide our types of community coverage. We may be looking at large increases in our premium.

Water, water everywhere! Our association has spent thousands on water leaks and sewer backups. It was passed to receive a grant from Pinellas County for replacement of freshwater water and sewer lines that should start this year. This is an approximate savings of three and half million dollars to our residents.

Costs have risen for all us. Our vendors all have had increases, pool service, lawn mowers, Trugreen, etc. Unfortunately, they are costs we all have to bear.

The area behind the maintenance shed is being repurposed for corn hole and other activities. Golf cart parking was added in two areas. A larger bicycle rack was placed near the pool as was requested by so many residents. This enabled us to move the existing rack for use near the exercise room.

Holiday Shores is a five star park that is the envy of many surrounding communities. We have high standards in our community and live up to them. We have a group of caring residents that are always there to help one another. There are many committees and groups that would love your input. I encourage all of you to get involved ! We need to hear from many voices. The forming of new committees takes place in January and the members are approved by the new Board of Directors. Sign up sheets are available or you may show interest by email. The new Board will look at the requests and try to involve as many folks as possible. We have had a terrific board this past year and I have enjoyed working with these dedicated and conscientious folks.

Overnight parking in the Clubhouse lot requires a permit. You can obtain your parking permit from the Park office, Monday through Friday, from 9am to noon. If you are arriving at night, or over the weekend, please call the office (727-393-5916) and advise us accordingly. You can then pick up your permit the next business day should you want to continue to park in the lot there for an extended period of time.

Parking your car, RV, truck, van, etc., on the grass is not permitted at any time. Golf cart are permitted to park on the grass in the designated areas.

Please do not:

- walk pets in the grass behind people's homes. This is for resident privacy and your safety. You are also required to clean up after your pet whenever walking them the Park.
- address any Park vendors with issues you may have with them, or their company. If you have a complaint, or issue, please formally report it to the office by filling out an Input Form which addresses complaints, concerns, recommendations and comments. The complaints are kept confidential and go on record for action, reference, and follow-up.

Trugreen fertilizes and sprays for weeds every other month. Please do not stop the service person, while they are working, to discuss your issue with your lawn. The office will provide Trugreen with a list of those of you who formally register a complaint with the office so that they can address your specific concerns - <u>as long as these services are within our service contract</u>. If you would like to be on that list you must come to the office and fill out an "Input Sheet" to register your complaint.

John Gramatikis has volunteered to dispose of any leftover paint. Should you have paint that you want to discard, please drop your paint cans off by the dumpster at the maintenance shed and John will properly dispose of it. Thank you, John!

Finally, please refer to your Rules and Regulations book whenever you have any questions, or intend to make permanent or temporary changes to your home, carport or within 36". If you can't find your answer there, call, email, or come to the office. We are happy to help you.






