GERMS IN THE POOL – A GUIDE FOR SWIMMERS

here's a different kind of pool safety and it's not your swimming skill. It's how you protect yourself and others from bacteria and germs. These can be reduced with some responsible behaviors.



- 1. Stay out of the water if you have diarrhea. Don't go back into the water until two weeks after diarrhea has completely stopped.
- **2. Shower before you swim.** Rinsing off in the shower for 1-minute removes most of the dirt or anything else on your body that uses up pool chemicals to kill germs.
- **3. Don't swallow the water.** The number one way to protect yourself from germs is to avoid swallowing the water.
- **4. Take frequent bathroom breaks.** Have kids with you? Check diapers every hour and change them away from the water to keep germs from contaminating it.
- **5. Protect open cuts or wounds.** It's best to stay out of the water, especially if the cut or wound is the result of recent surgery or piercing. If you do go in, use waterproof bandages to completely cover the cut or wound.


