From the Board of Directors

The Annual General Members Meeting will be held on February 21, 2023 at 7pm for the purpose of hearing reports of committees and election of new Directors for the Board. This is an important meeting and all residents are urged to attend. We need a quorum to conduct this meeting. Please mark your calendar and plan to attend.

The Board will not be dealing with a large number of new projects this year. It will, however, be conducting a Reserve Study, which is an independent analysis of our Reserves, with recommendations to adjust our Reserves to meet the needs for our future. This review is required every 5 years. It will be conducted by an outside specialty company. They will make several in-person visits, looking over our infrastructure and common areas. They will then recommend an amount that is required for the upkeep of Blue Jay.

A recent incident, which resulted in a golf cart ending up in Pelican Lake and damage to our newly installed lake sock, installed at great expense to protect the banks on our ponds, highlights the importance of adhering to our rules and regulations. Rule 11 in Resident Rules and Regulations states "Golf carts should be driven by a licensed driver or, if an unlicensed driver and under the age of 16, they MUST have a licensed driver accompanying them in the front passenger seat." There were 2 people in the golf cart that went into the lake. Neither had a driver's license. While there is no indication of excessive speed, it is clear that the driver lost control when they hit one of our speed bumps, and careened into the lake. Fortunately there were no serious injuries, but it is a reminder that we have rules for a reason. Please take this opportunity to re-read the "yellow section" of your Blue Book.

In a recent drive through, while most houses are in great shape, it was noticed that there were some houses that had mold on the house, roof, and especially on the bricks of planters. Now is a good time of year to take some time to walk around your home and check for issues with dirt and mold. It will be easier to clean now while the weather is cooler than to wait until it is hot again. Mold continues to be a problem for all of us and only by keeping on top of it in the beginning do we stand a chance of controlling it. Your cooperation in keeping Blue Jay beautiful is appreciated.

We have already had to close the pool for a few nights because of the overnight temperatures. We will probably need to do so again. The pool is closed whenever we expect nighttime temperatures to fall below 55 degrees. We have been informed by our pool heater company that failure to do so could cause our heater to burn out, and the cost of a new heater is approximately \$25,000.

Finally, we are about to enter a period in which we see many winter visitors coming down from the northern regions in search for some warm weather. This usually includes a visit to the pool. If your visitors are going to the pool please remind them of our pool rules. Most important is a pre-swim shower and a reminder that no oils are allowed in the pool. Remember, these products will destroy our pool filters and cause us to undergo a very expensive replacement. Staining can already be seen on the underwater surface, installed just a few years ago. This staining has only one cause – tanning oils. Cleaning it will be expensive. It is your money, folks, which will be used to do the cleaning. And the pool will need to be drained to do it. We just had a \$16 per month increase in our monthly fees. We don't need to have any more of an increase for something that is so simple to control. This one is entirely in your hands.
