

MORE RECIPES FROM THE 2009 LAKE HIGHLANDER COOKBOOK

PORK AND APPLES WITH STUFFING

by Mariette Kennedy

12 boneless pork chops or tenderloin pieces
2 cans 20 oz. apple pie slices, drained
½ c. brown sugar
6 cups herb seasoned stuffing mix
½ c. chopped celery
¼ c. butter, melted
3 T. instant minced onions
1 t. salt
½ t. ground sage
2 c. beef bouillon



Sprinkle pork with salt and pepper. In a large skillet, brown well on both sides. Place in 2 -9×12 baking pans. Combine apples and brown sugar. Spoon over pork. Combine stuffing mix, celery, melted butter, onion, salt and sage; toss with beef bouillon until moistened. Spread evenly over apple mixture. Bake at 375 degrees for 1 hour. (Second casserole may be covered and frozen. To cook, set oven at 400 degrees and cook for 1 ¹/₄ hrs.)

GRANDMA'S SOFT MOLASSES COOKIES

5 c. flour
2 t. baking soda
1 t. ginger
1 t. cinnamon
½ t. salt
¾ c. shortening
1 c. sugar
1 c. molasses
2 eggs
½ c. sour cream
Cream shortening with sugar. Add molasses and blend well. Add eggs and dry ingredients.
Add sour cream last. Drop by spoonfuls onto ungreased baking sheet and bake for 10 minutes at 375 degrees.

BLAST FROM THE PAST

This article was shared with me by Mary Ann Uzzi, Lot #120. It was written by Alice Romero (Mary Ann Uzzi's aunt) and taken from her diary from 1969, and printed in the September, 1992, Piper. Enjoy!

The fateful days of 1969 were beautiful happy days for us.

Jan. 29, 1969: On our way to spend four weeks at Sea Grape Lodge in Fort Myers, we stopped for the night at Jamaica Inn in Dunedin – a little town on the west coast of Florida.



While there we phoned friends from N.J. – Lou & Marian Fraser, who lived at Lake Highlander Park. We learned they were on a trip to Mexico.

March 2, 1969: Left Ft. Meyers and drove to Fort Pierce on the east coast. However, instead of continuing north to our home in Weehawken, NJ, for some unknown reason we crossed the state to Dunedin.

March 10, 1969: Registered at Jamaica Inn again. This time we reached our friends, the Frasers, on the phone, and were invited to visit them.

March 15, 1969: Having seen beautiful L.H.M.P., we decided to buy our place at #120 for a winter home! The very next day we left for home in N.J.

May 8, 1969: Returned to Dunedin and our winter home for a 3-week vacation.

May 10, 1969: Shopping, shopping, and shop again. Had our first swim in the park pool. Fabulous! At 10:30 a.m. we had coffee and donuts in the clubhouse for Coffee Hour. Met Peg and Arthur Owens and arranged to go on a boat ride on Thursday.

May 13, 1969: After lunch, a swim in the pool, met Florence Paul and Millie Burns. John & Lou Fraser worked on our lawn. After dinner, visited Bea & Bill Hargraves.

May 15, 1969: Went on the park's Boat Ride trip to Bahia Beach across Tampa Bay. Had a picnic and returned about 5:30 p.m. Beautiful fun day!

May 19, 1969: The Hargraves took us up to Tarpon Springs to get fresh shrimp right off the boat. We filled a bucket full -7 lbs. for 75 cents a lb.! Beautiful afternoon and a swim in the pool, and, of course, a shrimp dinner at home.

May 19: Walked 3 miles on Clearwater Beach, saw several porpoises, returned home for lunch. Another wonderful day, and a swim in the pool, too.

May 29: Went to the Pancake House on 580 (now Kally K's) for breakfast and left for home in NJ for the summer.

Nov. 13, 1969: We arrived back to #120 after lunch, made beds, and unpacked. At 5:00 p.m. attended a Potluck Dinner at the clubhouse with the Hargraves, danced and sang for hours!

Nov. 16, 1969: Beautiful cool day. Registered as a parishioner after 9:30 Mass at Our Lady of Lourdes Church in Dunedin. We attended a lovely concert in the clubhouse by the Dunedin H.S. Choral Group. We had dinner and took a walk – met Ann & Jim Davis of #119 across the corner from us. We love it here!

Nov. 18, 1969: A warm sunny day to drive out on the Causeway. John fished and I read. After supper, walked with Bill & Bea Hargrave to the high school to see a travelog on Jamaica and met Jim & Ann there. We all walked home together.

Nov. 27, 1969: Thanksgiving Day. A wonderful dinner at the clubhouse. Supposed to have a Turkey Shoot-Out on the shuffleboard courts, but it rained, so we gathered around the piano with Millie Burns and sang. Later danced until 5:00. Then home to relax on our porch. A truly delightful day.

Dec. 12, 1969: Shopped all morning and John shuffled all afternoon. I rested! Spent the evening with Hargraves together with Bert & Elsie Landphair.

January 12, 2023, 7:00 p.m. -- We had a great turnout of 111 Units represented. Thank you all for coming! The Presidents Report showed that we started an Alteration Committee; began mandatory Orientation for new owners; reviewed an Electronic Voting system that ultimately was not put into play; put in new Washers/Dryers and rehabbed the laundry room; instituted new metal mail boxes; got Insurance
