

Officer Charles Skipper explained the usefulness and role of a neighborhood watch. He also provided many tips and tricks on how to make your coach less desirable to a thief trying to rob or trying to break in. Use signs or additional measures for additional security:

- · Beware of dog
- Wi-Fi security cameras
- Upgrade your locks or dead bolts

If you see something in our neighborhood that looks suspicious, you should call the non-emergency neighborhood watch line on 727-582-6200 to report. Thank you to Officer Skipper for conducting a valuable session.

If you have not yet joined the HOA, please take a moment to reconsider. The Riviera Estates HOA helps with the following:

- Promote a good relationship, cooperate with Park Management and Owners in maintaining & improving Standards of Mobile Home living.

Best Sound Mixing also goes to Larry Burnett because the music was so mixed up we didn't know if we should be shocked or start dancing.



Bake covered in 350 degree oven for 45 to 60 minutes, no longer


