FROM THE PRESIDENT

Well, we are off and running for the New Year. I am writing this to help all of us better understand a problem that impacts all of us, not just those who live on the canal.

Cross Bayou Canal Issue Exposed

Friends, this is becoming very serious. Clearwater Cascade HOA is a cooperative, meaning all shareholders are equal partners in our park and the park's land. This is not just a problem for the residents that live on the canal. This is a problem for the entire community and it is not going away. The longer we ignore it, the more and more expensive it will be to resolve for all of our residents. We need to get more informed and be involved in the solution that we hope comes soon.

We have a very high turbidity and this is a serious problem!

We are losing more ground on our banks and as a result, the sandbars are growing and the turbidity is getting is worse. What is turbidity you ask? It is the cloudiness or haziness of a fluid caused by large amounts of individual particles that are generally invisible to the naked eye, similar to smoke in air. The measurement of turbidity is a key test of both water clarity and water quality. High turbidity is a problem for wildlife (fish, turtles, manatees, etc.). This also affects the water birds searching for food.

The kayak launch is mostly grounded now and as a result the kayakers are unable to enter the waterway. No one can get through under the railroad trestle due to the condensed brushes and trees that block the flow of the water.

The canal has a very slow water flow. This low and slow flow characteristic does "not" support strong debris flushing. As a result, obstructions do not get moved on by tidal or storm water moving through.

Sometime back, the Bardmoor Golf & Tennis Club aka the Bayou Club placed a small culvert on their golf course that is much too small for the proper water flow. We have not been able to ascertain whether it was properly permitted when installed. This restricted water flow from this culvert has resulted in an altered Cross Bayou Canal and a major reason for our bank erosion issues.

Pinellas County nor their Public Works division have been the least bit interested in helping us to resolve this problem. Sandy Draper has been a frontline advocate seeking assistance from all available sources including the State of Florida.

However, we need your involvement. We may be contacting the media shortly to come out so we can tell our story. When this happens, we need as many residents to show up for the cameras. Watch for this announcement. We also need you to come to the Cross Bayou Canal Committee meetings. Watch for the next meeting announcement on VOLO, Facebook and the official postings at the mailboxes and library.

Alteration Requests – This is just a reminder that any changes to the outside of your home must be approved by the Alteration Committee and two Board Members prior to starting any project.

<u>CWC Decals</u> – We have noticed some residents do not have CWC Decals on their vehicles. All residents must have one. If you do not have a decal on your vehicle, please bring your registration up to the office. We will make a copy and issue you a new Decal. In addition, all golf carts need to have their Lot number on them. We have decals for the golf carts in the office.

<u>Library Windows Update</u> – We are still waiting for some windows to be replaced and work to be done around the windows in the library. Due to supply issues, we do not have a date when they will arrive yet. Once they are installed, the windows will have to be inspected and then we can remove all the stickers and we will have the windows cleaned.

<u>Tax Exemptions</u> – In addition to a Homestead Exemption for year around residents, there are several other exemptions you may qualify for. Some examples are: Widow/Widower Exemption, Blind Persons Exemption, Disability Exemptions, Disabled Veterans or Surviving Spouse Exemptions, and Low-Income Senior Exemption. The deadline to file for these exemptions is March 1, 2021. For more information, contact the Pinellas County Property Appraiser's Office by calling 727-464-3207 or visit their new office located at 2500 34th Street North, Second Floor.

Office Closure- The business office will be closed February 20th for President's Day.

<u>Estoppel</u> – Funny word, isn't it...if you are buying a home in a deed restricted community, you will be asked if you want to purchase an Estoppel. It is an added expense; however, it is to protect the purchaser. Estoppels will show if there are any outstanding violations for the home you may be purchasing, it will show if taxes are owed on the home, or if the seller has an outstanding balance on their account. When you purchase a new home in a deed restricted community or park, you agree to abide by the governing documents AND you become responsible for any outstanding violations or money owed. In other words, buyer beware.

That is all I have for this month, stay safe.













I am proud of what has been accomplished and while our Boards have not been able to please everyone, I believe everyone can see the improvements.



rash collection days are Tuesdays and Fridays, with Recycling on Wednesdays in the Park. Our trash collectors are great, picking up and disposing of almost anything that we put to the curb. As you drive around the park on trash collection days you'll see trash bags, shipping and packing boxes, toilets, cabinets, etc. out for pickup. Since the pandemic, many of us are utilizing the delivery services of companies such as Amazon, Wayfair, Chewey,

and others. Shopping with these suppliers is convenient and time-saving. And it creates a pile of cardboard to dispose of. Unfortunately, many of these cardboard shipping containers go into the trash collection on Tuesday and Friday instead of the recycling collection on Wednesday. I say unfortunately because Clearwater Cascade receives a yearly rebate payment for our

recyclables that are collected on Wednesday. Once a year we receive a check divided equally between the Social Club and the Park. The Social Club's share is used to support their efforts such as breakfasts and dinners and entertainment. The Park's share can be used by the Board to support the activities in the Park. Only recyclables, such as cardboard, put out on Wednesdays for recycling count toward the rebate. Any recyclables you dispose of on Tuesday and Friday just go into the landfill. Drive around the Park on trash days and you'll see the money we are losing. Hopefully, we will all make an extra effort to keep our recyclables for Wednesday's recycling. It will benefit everyone.


