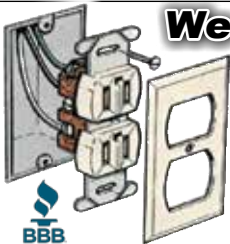

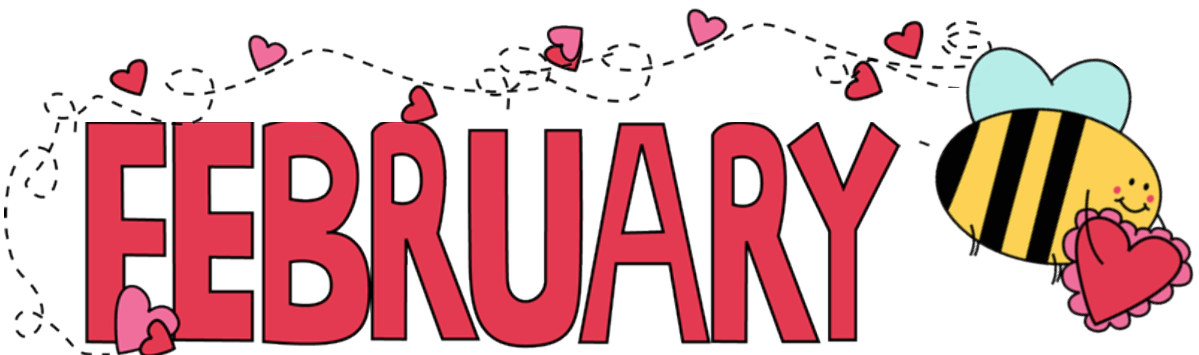

LINCOLNSHIRE HISTORY:

.....A Continued story- - -

LARGO....THE....CITY: It was May 4th of 1935 when an act of the State Legislature said Largo was a town no more. A new charter was adopted, and the “City of Largo” came into being and the city limits were extended in all directions to include an area of 8 square miles.

Cattle ranching, poultry raising, citrus and a new camphor industry sparked the economy. Largo continued to pass bond issues to continue improvements.

Then came the great depression

Many cities across the country were financially burdened – including Largo. The city was thousands of dollars in debt due to the many bonds issued for civic improvements.

In 1933 after long drawn-out legal proceedings, a ruling by the state supreme court ended the city of Largo stating the “city” was invalid. The city of Largo was bankrupt! Largo pulled back the boundaries and was once again the Town of Largo – all the way back to its ¾ mile boundaries of 1913.

Over the next few years, Largo struggled with the rest of the state to pay off debts. Then in the 1950’s northern visitors began coming got Largo to buy winter homes and property. Sound familiar? Largo was on the verge of relief, and the legislature voted to allow depressed areas to get economic aid by starting up a cigarette tax - - wow – Largo literally “smoked it’s way out of debt”

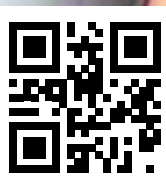

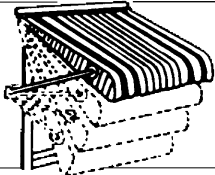

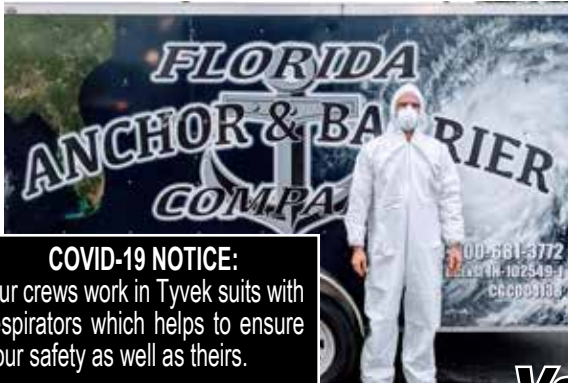

VETERAN'S CORNER

This year several of your neighbors from Lincolnshire participated in the Wreaths Across America ceremony at Bay Pines Cemetery. Bob Behm, Eric and Mary Salaby, Noreen Locke picture below.

Morrill Worcester, owner of Worcester Wreath Company of Harrington, Maine, was a 12-year-old paper boy for the Bangor Daily News when he won a trip to Washington D.C. His first trip to our nation's capital was one he would never forget, and Arlington National Cemetery made an especially indelible impression on him. This experience followed him throughout his life and successful career, reminding him that his good fortune was due, in large part, to the values of this nation and the veterans who made the ultimate sacrifice for their country. In 1992, Worcester Wreath found themselves with a surplus of wreaths nearing the end of the holiday seas. With the aid of Maine Senator Olympia Snowe, arrangements were made for the wreaths to be placed at Arlington in one of the older sections of the cemetery that had been receiving fewer visitors with each passing year.

As plans were underway, several other individuals and organizations stepped up to help. James Prout, owner of local trucking company Blue Bird Ranch, Inc., generously provided transportation all the way to Virginia. Volunteers from the local American Legion and VFW Posts gathered with members of the community to decorate each wreath with traditional red, hand-tied bows. Members of the Maine State Society of Washington, D.C. helped to organize

the wreath-laying, which included a special ceremony at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. In 2005, a photo of the stones at Arlington, adorned with wreaths and covered in snow, circulated around the internet. Suddenly, the project received national attention. Thousands of requests poured in from all over the country from people wanting to help with Arlington, to emulate the Arlington project at their National and State cemeteries, or to simply share their stories and thank Morrill Worcester for honoring our nation's heroes. Unable to donate thousands of wreaths to each state, Worcester began sending seven wreaths to every state, one for each branch of the military, and for POW/MIAs. In 2006, with the help of the Civil Air Patrol and other civic organizations, simultaneous wreath-laying ceremonies were held at over 150 locations around the country. The Patriot Guard Riders volunteered as escort for the wreaths going to Arlington. This began the annual "Veterans Honor Parade" that travels the east coast in early December. The annual trip to Arlington and the groups of volunteers eager to participate in Worcester's simple wreath-laying event grew each year until it became clear the desire to remember and honor our country's fallen heroes was bigger than Arlington, and bigger than this one company. In 2007, the Worcester family, along with veterans, and other groups and individuals who had helped with their annual veteran's wreath ceremony in Arlington, formed Wreaths Across America, a non-profit organization, to continue and expand this effort, and support other groups around the country who wanted to do the same. This year across the United States, volunteers honored Veterans by placing wreaths at about 2.7 million gravesites in 3,702 locations on Wreath Across America Day, Dec. 17. As each wreath was carefully placed, the volunteer says the name of the deceased veteran's name out loud, ensuring their memory lives on. The sad thing was that the Wreaths are purchased by donations and there were not enough wreaths for every grave this year especially at our own Veterans Cemetery Bay Pines. Next year maybe you might go to the website for Wreaths Across America Website and purchase a wreath to honor our Veteran's and maybe also participate in a Wreath Laying event.

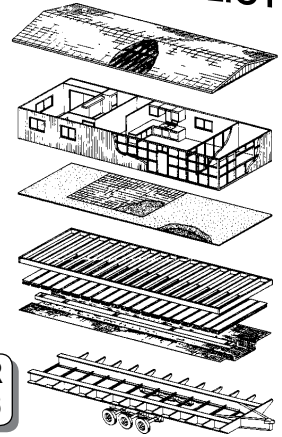

A Nurse's Self Care Toolbox #57

This month the focus is the essential steps that keep our bodies prepared throughout the day and through the night. There are 4 pretty basic actions that occur in how we use our food (sugar and other nutrients.) What we eat, how much we eat, when we eat (a newer issue) and the last important one which is what we do with the food (movement.) I really don't like the word "exercise." Bet you don't either.

1. What we eat. Each food group has a sugar load. Often called "carbs." Each food group has its own time to become usable sugar, pass quickly into our blood stream and meet "insulin" made fresh daily and hourly in our pancreas that escorts the sugar into each and every cell. Candy or fruit juice is the fastest (seconds) and meat the longest (almost an hour.) Complex and processed foods usually have multiple food groups. A can of spaghetti with meat balls has sugar, starches, tomato which also a fruit and hopefully protein in the meat. So almost all is broken down to sugar and in our blood starting within minutes to probably 40 minutes later. Oh, corn syrup and especially high fructose corn syrup are sugar sweeteners too.
2. How much we eat. Eating more than recommended in each food group means too much sugar will be available immediately or an hour from now when you really need some right now. Which makes our body "make" sugar even though you just ate. Oh boy! Or you get the sugar when you aren't going to use it. Another Oh boy!
3. When we eat. May be a new one for most of us. We were designed to get fresh food (sugar) every 3-4 hours after getting up at DAWN. Yes DAWN. All day until dusk. When we don't follow this there is metabolic chaos and confusion. We don't get food when our body first needs it (skipping breakfast) and eating at the end of the day when things are winding down. The end result is no fresh food (sugar) when our system is looking for it and then food (sugar) when not needed. Our body has to make sugar when it has been denied (yes denied) and store sugar when it isn't being used (fat or excessive blood sugars.) If our pancreas could talk to most of us it would be screaming for calm. It would tell us to eat what we were designed to eat, the quantities we were designed to find during the day and when, along our daily trail (movement) we would find it.
4. Movement. Formerly "exercise" for me. Simple. We ate and moved to eat, ate and moved until dusk when we found safety to sleep. Started all over the next day. If the average time the sugar is available to us is 40 minutes after we swallow, then do something and move. Walk, vacuum, ride a bike, move!! Go bother your neighbors like I do. Our muscles use the most sugar!!! I mean it. Use them no matter how small the muscle, it is using sugar. Then have something to eat 3 hours later. It truly is simple. Get up, eat, move, eat move.....go

to bed without a napkin on our laps.

The goal is not ending up with so much sugar (gas) in our tank when we aren't going (driving) anywhere. Fall asleep with enough sugar to get you to the morning when breakfast is waiting. Breakfast is not a donut and coffee! Of course you knew that. Next month is solely on diabetes. Chew well my friends.

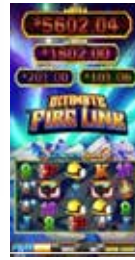

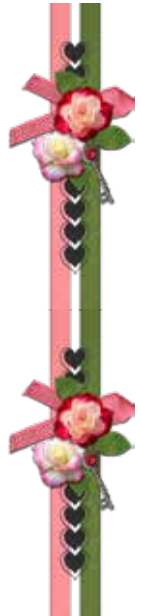

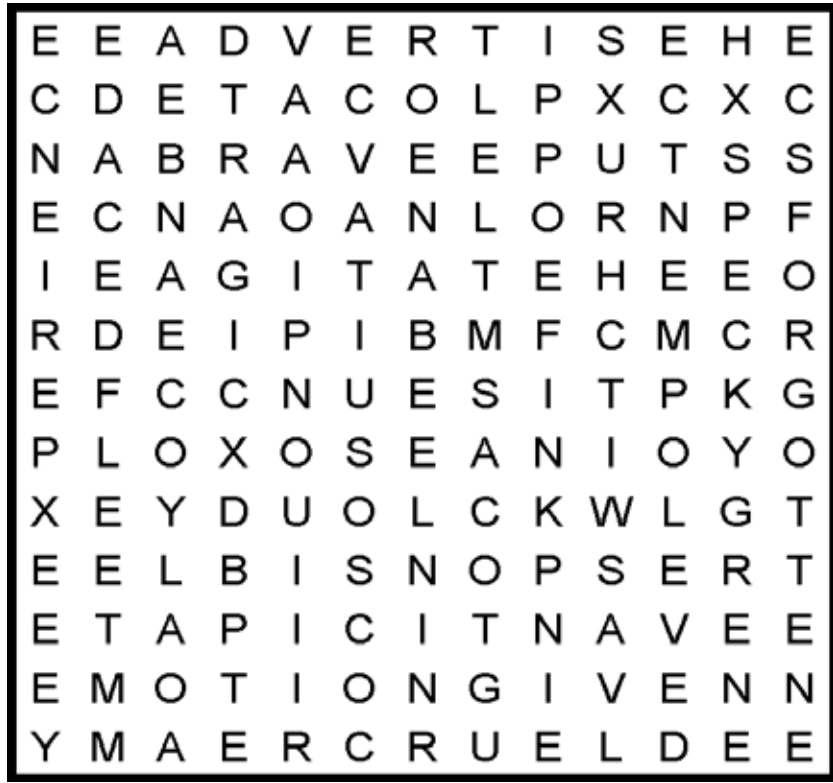
