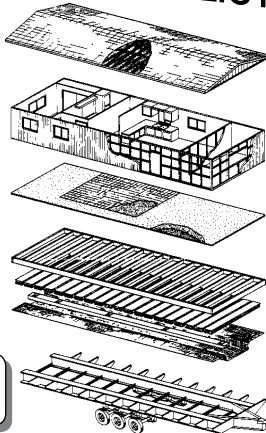

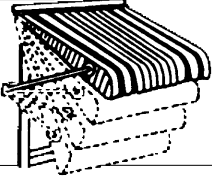

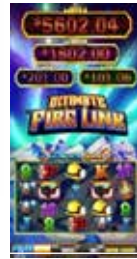

Alcohol in Pool Area

Please remember that no glass of any kind is allowed around the pool area. We are getting reports of beer bottles around the pool. If glass is broken in the pool, it can be quite expensive to clean out.

Please remember there is NO alcohol in the pool area, in the pool or hot tub.

The Hot Tub is for Adults Only



No one under 18 is permitted in the Hot Tub. Food and drink, of any kind, are not allowed in the pool or hot tub. The hot tub is meant for short sessions only, no longer than 15 minutes. The use of alcohol combined with the relaxing heat of the hot tub can be a dangerous combination. A person can easily slip under the water unnoticed, and tragedy can strike quickly. Never swim alone. Use the buddy system for safety.

Also, for the health and wellbeing of everyone, please do not go in the hot tub or pool if you are not feeling well, have wounds or open sores.

Guests

Additional guests staying overnight in the park must be registered and paid for. Cost is \$9 per person per night, \$55 per person per week and \$180 per person per month. Residents must accompany their guests while at the pool or other locations and are responsible for the behavior of their guests. Children under 18 must be accompanied by an adult who shall assume full responsibility for their safety and conduct.

Driveways

While backing out of your driveway, please stop and look before entering the street. There have been close calls with residents backing out and not looking. We strongly urge residents to obey the one-way arrows. We have seen many instances where someone has almost gotten hit because of someone going against the arrows.



Mowing

If you have any problems with the mowing, please contact the office and not the mowing crew. The office will contact the manager and get the situation resolved as quickly as possible.

Golf Carts

Golf carts are only to be driven by persons 18 years old and older with a valid driver's license and you should obey the speed limits within the park.



Dog Poop

We have received many complaints about people not cleaning up after their animals and not walking them in the pet area. Pet areas are marked on the map.

Also, all the sports enthusiasts would appreciate it if you did not allow your pets to defecate in the pits that we use for Volleyball, Horseshoes and Petanque. If an accident should happen, please pick up the poop.

If you need a copy of the map, stop in the office for one. Thank you.

Fire Hydrants

We have been asked to advise you not to hang anything on the fire hydrants. It will hinder the fire department if they must come into the park.

To All Residents - Royal Palm Cemetery

Royal Palm Cemetery is now off limits to all residents with dogs. The cemetery will be putting up “no trespassing” signs for anyone with a dog. There have been many complaints that people are taking their dogs to the cemetery for walks and not cleaning up after them. Anyone caught on cemetery property will be prosecuted.

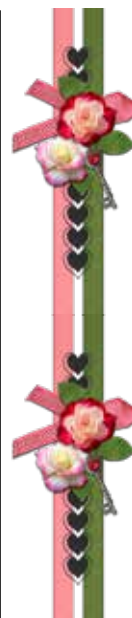
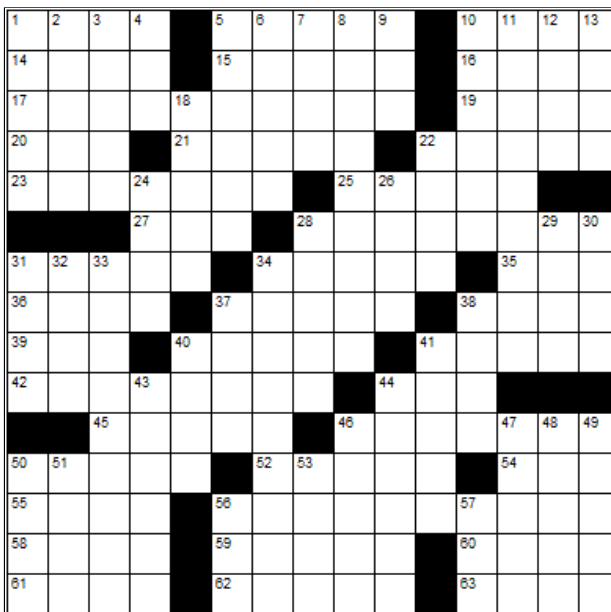
