RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Carrot Cake

Ingredients:

- 2 cups sugar
- 1 ³/₄-2 cups salad oil
- 1 tsp vanilla
- 4 eggs (add one at a time)

Mix together, then add:

- 2 cups flour
- 1 tsp baking soda
- 1 tsp baking powder
- 1 ½ tsp cinnamon

Mix together, then add:

2 cups grated carrot

Nuts and raisins (optional), quantity as desired

Bake at 350 degrees for 30 - 35 minutes

- 4 oz cream cheese
- ½ cup powdered sugar
- 1 tsp vanilla
- Drops of milk, as needed



FROM THE OFFICE

Tust a reminder that rent went up \$30 for all mobile homes as of Jan. 1, 2023. So far 42 people have paid the wrong amount!



After not having a park wide yard sale for several years, we scheduled one in January. Only 21 unit out of approx. 375 participated!

The new fence at the 12th street laundromat will be installed soon. Please use common sense and do not hang your laundry out when they are working there.

I currently have the residents at 4 mobiles being evicted for having "non-qualified" residents living there. Rule 4.C OCCUPANCY, states that every resident must be approved by Park Management. It is unfortunate if you have a family member lose their lodging, but they cannot just "move in" with Mom and/or Dad. A reminder that after 48 hours the office must be notified of any additional person at your residence, and they need to supply the office with valid ID. Park Management can then allow them to stay up to 30 days; however, when they are here because they have just been released from jail and need an address for the courts, EMBASSY IS NOT IT! Also understand that an eviction does not just remove that person, but everyone at the mobile, including the owner. The argument that you own the mobile and should be allowed to let anyone you want to live there is invalid; every resident has signed that they received a copy of the park rules, and residency is addressed in many different rules.

We continue to have major garbage issues; residents that have been here a long time continue to throw boxes in the mixed recyclable bins without them being broke down. Other residents have the attitude (and have verbally stated) that they pay their rent and don't care! Read rule 19. **TRASH/GARBAGE** and Rule 35B. **DEFAULT AND EVICTIONS**, which says you can be evicted for violating park rules.....and I will!

Please check out the calendar in this issue, there are a lot of fun activities going on, whether you want to participate in or just go enjoy.
