



A Couple of Firsts Since COVID!







#### **Cranberry Pineapple Jell-O Salad**

- 1 can 20-ounce, crushed pineapple undrained
- Two packages 4 oz. each Jell-O raspberry
- One can whole berry cranberry sauce
- 1 medium, apple, chopped
- 2/3 cups, chopped walnuts



Drain pineapple save juice. Add enough water to the pineapple juice to make 3 cups. Pour into saucepan. Bring to a boil. Remove from heat. Add Jell-O Stir 2 minutes till dissolved. Add cranberry sauce till well blended. Pour into bowl. Refrigerate for 1 1/2 hours till slightly thickened consistency of a unbeaten egg whites. Stir in pineapple, apple, and walnuts into the Jell-O. Refrigerate 4 hours until firm.

- 2 tablespoons of raisins
- Salt and pepper to taste



Combine mustard, vinegar, salt, and pepper. Mix well. Add oil and mix until combined and add lettuce. Add to salad. Mix walnuts and raisins. Toss with dressing. Enjoy!




