Cranberry Pineapple Jell-O Salad



- 1 can 20-ounce, crushed pineapple undrained
- Two packages 4 oz. each Jell-O raspberry
- One can whole berry cranberry sauce
- 1 medium, apple, chopped
- 2/3 cups, chopped walnuts

Drain pineapple save juice. Add enough water to the pineapple juice to make 3 cups. Pour into saucepan. Bring to a boil. Remove from heat. Add Jell-O Stir 2 minutes till dissolved. Combine mustard, vinegar, salt, and pepper. Mix well. Add oil and mix until combined and add lettuce. Add to salad. Mix walnuts and raisins. Toss with dressing. Enjoy!

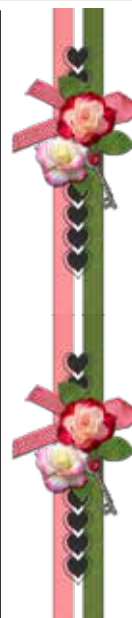
