### Long Range Planning Committee Update

or the past year, the LRPC has visited comparable residential communities, interviewed contractors, vendor suppliers and asked many questions and concerns pertaining to design, maintenance, installation, and traffic concerns for a new Front Gate.

The committee presented to the Board a request for \$15,000 to prepare documentation that would be needed for submission to the town of Largo to move forward. The estimated budget pricing received by the committee and submitted to the Board at that time based on early quotations was approximately \$165,000 plus tax in 2022. In December 2022, a dialog was initiated with a representative from the Largo Planning Board resulting an email from the Largo Planning Division stating FV does not need to have a professional proposal. The communication also advised that a survey for the concept plan would be helpful to assess the amount of space needed for access to the area connecting to Belcher Road. We than located the actual plot plan for FV with detailed square feet of the front entrance.

Based upon the letter and expenditure approval the next steps of the committee are to obtain conceptual drawing and provide them to a contractor to obtain more current budget pricing leading to a formal quotation from certified contractors.

The committees next steps are to meet with residents for a Q&A session in the hope that a final proposal to the Board could be presented and finalized. The committee is committed to keeping Shareholders informed and will provide you with regular updates, and all Shareholders are welcome to the meetings. 




