Long Range Planning Committee Update

For the past year, the LRPC has visited comparable residential communities, interviewed contractors, vendor suppliers and asked many questions and concerns pertaining to design, maintenance, installation, and traffic concerns for a new Front Gate.

The committee presented to the Board a request for \$15,000 to prepare documentation that would be needed for submission to the town of Largo to move forward. The estimated budget pricing received by the committee and submitted to the Board at that time based on early quotations was approximately \$165,000 plus tax in 2022. In December 2022, a dialog was initiated with a representative from the Largo Planning Board resulting an email from the Largo Planning Division stating FV does not need to have a professional proposal. The communication also advised that a survey for the concept plan would be helpful to assess the amount of space needed for access to the area connecting to Belcher Road. We then located the actual plot plan for FV with detailed square feet of the front entrance.

Based upon the letter and expenditure approval the next steps of the committee are to obtain conceptual drawing and provide them to a contractor to obtain more current budget pricing leading to a formal quotation from certified contractors.

The committees next steps are to meet with residents for a Q&A session in the hope that a final proposal to the Board could be presented and finalized. The committee is committed to keeping Shareholders informed and will provide you with regular updates, and all Shareholders are welcome to the meetings. 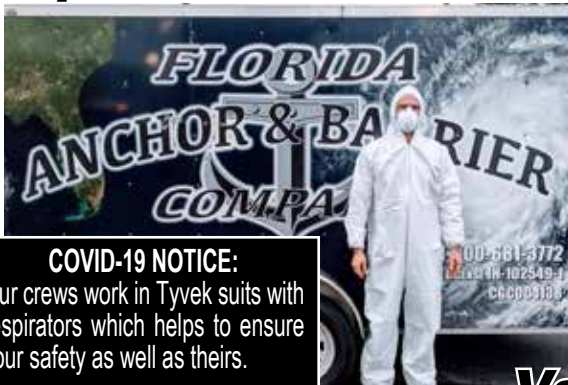

5 Ways to Reset Your Body and Brain- *Do you want to feel lighter, stronger and smarter?*

- **Fix your bad breath** – instead for breathing through your open mouth; force yourself to breathe through your nose. This will help you breathe deeper sending Nitric oxide throughout your body. By opening up your paranasal sinuses it will increase the oxygenation in your whole body and brain.
- **Watch what you put down the hatch** – By eating whole foods, fresh produce, drinking LOTS of water and herbal tea and limiting processed/fried foods, sugar/sweeteners, alcohol/caffeine will not only help you to lose weight, but feel less pain in the joints. Instead of focusing on deprivation, focus on eating for how you want to feel.

- **Move it or lose it** – In the winter months we become more sedentary. In a very short time, you begin to lose your cardio endurance. In a week you lose muscle. Intentional movement with resistance will help maintain strength and build up metabolism. Short bouts of movement will increase your human growth hormone, which helps cell regeneration, including bone density.
