RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Pineapple Pound Cake

Ingredients:

Mix together well:

2 ³/₄ cups sugar

1 lb butter

1 tsp vanilla

6 eggs


Then add:

3 cups flour

1 tsp baking powder

1/4 cup evaporated milk

³/₄ cup pineapple – crushed and drained



While cooling, make topping:

Heat 1 stick butter

1 cup crushed pineapple with liquid

1 ½ cup powdered sugar

Ingredients will thicken somewhat

Remove cake from pan while it is still warm, but not hot. Poke holes all over the top of the cake. Spoon topping over the cake allowing it to soak into the holes.



FROM THE OFFICE

The Office

t is hard to believe that another "season" is almost over! Soon the snowbirds will pack up and leave, activities will wind down, and the beautiful 90 - degree weather will arrive.

We have 3 Holiday's during the summer, Memorial Day, 4th of July, and Labor Day. Park year-round residents enjoy getting together for a BBQ or picnic style meal, but no one volunteers to help. Ron Russell and Mike Matheny (Little Mike) have tried to do at least 1 of these a year, but it is time for other people to step up and organize one of these events. Ron, Mike, or I will gladly give you tips and ideas that have worked (or not!) and help you be a Host. Contact Ron or me at least a month before the holiday if you are willing to be the event coordinator.

Guests----first of all, guests over a few days need to provide the office with valid ID; if they have been here before, an email or phone call to the office to let us know the dates they will be here is required. IF your guest has a DOG, it must be approved before they arrive! The same dog rules apply for "guest" dogs.... under 40 pounds, certain breeds not allowed, must be on a leash and cannot be walked in the park.

Guests when the owner of the mobile is not going to be here must be approved in advance! Even then, you will be held responsible for their actions. I strongly discourage anyone having multiple guests in their absence; that is why there is a minimum rent stay of 30 days, so strange people are not coming and going.

By the time you read this there should be a new fence at the 12th street laundromat. This is another example of Mr. Larson continuing to improve/update the park. He is still working on getting some roads redone, but when blacktop is available, the cost has become exorbitant. In the meantime, we will continue to put gravel and dirt in the larger holes in the 12th street parking lot. The camera is doing a great job at the 12th street parking lot. It is going to take a little time, but I will be installing one on 3rd street by the big dumpster. I am also working on creating a new Embassy Facebook page, where I will be posting pictures of the "garbage offenders". We recently had to pay a \$100 fee because someone put mattresses and fluorescent light bulbs in the recycle bins. I watched a U-Haul truck dump an entire load all over the ground and put items in the wrong dumpster; I was later told that a resident had told their family that "Embassy has a lot of dumpsters, bring your garbage here." These bins are for park residents only, not your friends who live elsewhere. I will prosecute any person who is not a resident that uses any of our dumpsters! Also, just to clarify, if you pay a contractor to do work in your mobile or yard, it is up to them to get rid of the garbage. If this is your type of work (remodeling, tree trimming, etc.) do not bring that here to dump off, use the county dump!

A reminder to only call Roy for emergencies after 6 p.m. or on the weekend. He has nothing to do with park management, does not want to hear your complaints, and cannot give you any answers regarding rent checks and people who break park rules. There are complaint forms on the office door 99% of the time, so please use them. They must be signed; while I will never




