Tow do I protect my car from being broken into?

- Roll the windows up
- Lock the car doors, thieves are more likely to keep moving if locked
- Keep your car free of any items that might look enticing. Thieves like to window shop!
- Park Šmart...in a well-lit area if possible
- Don't keep valuables in your car

The most common items stolen from cars tend to be electronics, personal information, and accessories.

At night, put the keys (especially keyless FOB) with you, rather than the front door.

Some people say to wrap them in foil, and here's why: Thieves can use special devices to amplify the fob signal or copy the code to access vehicles. Criminals can capture fob signals from outside homes, offices, hotel rooms and shopping malls, but the DIY aluminum foil cover makes that impossible by blocking the electromagnetic field.

They are attracted by cats, small dogs, small animals, pet food and garbage to name a few. They are also attracted to pet feces.

To keep yourself and your pet safe, please follow these guidelines and be safe! Do not keep or leave piles of any pet food outside your home, or anywhere in common areas. Clean up any pet feces from your yards or common areas. Keep your outside lights on if you are going to be outside. Carry a flashlight when walking around at night. Keep all garbage in containers. If confronted by a coyote, stand your ground. Don't run! They will chase you. Make a lot of noise to scare them away. Be safe.




