Alk This Way – 5 Ways to Maximize Your Time on The Trail. Nothing beats walking for a free and easy boost to your health, especially in March as the days become longer and seasonal changes begin to stir.

- 1 Get ready, get set...Hydrate! Drink some water before you head out; especially if it's hot or you tend to get cramps. Have a light snack if needed, but save meals for after your walk.
- 2 **Breathe like a yogi**...Lift your heart and relax your shoulders. Keep your chin lifted and lead the stride with your feet, not your nose. Fill entire rib cage with your breath. Breathe through your nose as much as possible.
- 3 **Beat your allergies**...If the pollen count is high, wear a mask or bandana. Opt for walking in open areas. Avoid dense areas, high traffic hours (exhaust fumes), and wear sunglasses to protect eyes from pollen.
- 4 **Feed your senses**...use your eyes to see something that brings you joy, use your sense of smell to breathe deep to feel the scent all the way through your body. Search with your ears for different sounds, enjoy the touch of silky leaves or the smoothness of a rock.
- 5 **Spike your intensity**...Increase your pace to a speedwalk or sprint. Move your arms, increase your heart rate; build more distance and frequency over time as your stamina allows. Skip, kick or hop, these moves increase bone density and balance!

Just remember to breathe deeply, keep smiling, get a little crazy, and keep moving. See you on the trail!





Before you begin your project, please obtain a home replacement or Modification Request form from the FVRA office or download it (click *Document and Links*; scroll down to *Forms*, click *Forms* and *Information Docs – Printable*, click on *ARC Modification Request Form* and return the completed form to the FVRA office. The ARC, which meets most Mondays in the Clubhouse, looks forward to working with you in replacing your home or planning the changes to the outside of your home.
