ince we must submit our articles early, at the time of this writing, the following is scheduled to take place in Four Seasons during the very busy month of March.

We anticipate closing on the sale of the park shares at the end of March, which means that all owners of coaches in FSE must have completed their updated contact information.

that all owners of coaches in FSE must have completed their updated contact information. This will enable the office to locate you for the remote signing of the new prospectus and lease agreement. These are extremely important, as this will lock in the 3% rental increase cap on your coach, not only for you, but your surviving spouse and children.

Also, since we still must govern the park as normal, if we do not close by March 30th, elections will take place for the Board of Directors at the annual shareholders meeting on March 31st. If we close on March 30th, the BOD will no longer exist as the governing entity in FSE. Legacy will assume that position, and the HOA will be the representative of all residents in FSE. The existing BOD will close out all accounts, pay off all bills, etc., but will have no other function in the park.

In closing, we are asking for the continued cooperation and patience of all residents while we transition to Legacy. We will strive to keep all informed as this process takes place.

Also, we really appreciated our guest speaker, Ron Kelly, for providing an update regarding the sale of the park to Legacy. He answered many of our questions. If you were unable to attend the meeting, you may review a full copy of the minutes of that meeting which will be posted in the HOA section of the bulletin board in the clubhouse.

One important take-away from Ron was the need for all of our homeowners to have filled out an Information Sheet and returned it to the office prior to the closing. That will enable the new park owner, after the closing, to provide all the homeowners with their new Lease (for signature by the homeowner and return to Legacy) and the Prospectus, both of which will explain the terms under which homeowners may reside in this park. These documents will serve to ensure that every homeowner in the park will have legal status as a Renter. Our HOA Board and other volunteers will have done their best to deliver the Homeowner Information Sheet to your doorstep during the month of February. If you have not received this sheet, filled it out and returned it to the office, please ask the Administrative Assistant in the Office for the form and get it completed.

It is our understanding that Legacy intends to notify as many homeowners as possible by using their email addresses. Therefore, please be sure that your current email address is up to date on the Homeowner Information Sheet. Also, if you are leaving the park for any length of time, please be sure to fill out the form at the office to let them know the dates you will not be here, especially if your absence from the park is within the first thirty days after the park sale has closed. We expect those communications (the Lease and Prospectus) will be sent out by Legacy during that timeframe.

By the time the next meeting rolls around, your Board will have met in order to become familiar with the organization and structure of the Association. Homeowners, it is important that you plan on attending our next HOA meeting which is scheduled to be held in the clubhouse March 2, 2023, at 10:00 a.m.

We are encouraging all our homeowners to become official dues-paying members of our association. Please join and attend our scheduled meetings so that you may have input as a homeowner. It is important to maintain our Homeowners Association as organized under the laws of the State of Florida in order to act for the benefit of its members in dealings with the owner of the park. Our Homeowners Association is your legal voice in order to represent all homeowners.

DO YOU KNOW THE FMO?

MO----WORKING FOR YOU:

In the last issue I informed you of items that the FMO has accomplished by legislative action in the past. FMO has worked for improvement in mobile home and manufactured home parks for 50 years.



For the upcoming FLORIDA legislative session, the FMO is working to have the next two items presented and passed.

- 1. ELIMINATE the sales tax on your home resales.
- 2. RESIDENT APPROVALS requests need to be completed within 15 days of when it is submitted AND the charge can only be what the Park Owner is charged for the service.

Many sales can and are lost because of owners being extremely slow, sometimes caused by personal conflict between you and the owner.

The following are items under consideration for submission to future legislative sessions in Tallahassee---achieving a discount for veterans, school tax elimination for 55 plus parks and security for fixed income persons living in our parks so that they are not removed for inability to pay.




