DID'JA KNOW??

The "X" at the end of "PHX" makes sense for Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport, but what about



"LAX" for Los Angeles and "PDX" for Portland? Turns out, the "X" is left over from the days when airports used two-letter codes from the National Weather Service. With the rapid growth of air travel, it soon became apparent that two letters wouldn't be enough. When International Air Transport Association (IATA) was established three-letter codes became the norm in the 1930's, some airports gained an "X" at the end. Then there's Sioux City Gateway Airport, which is blessed with the IATA code "SUX". In 1988 and 2002, officials petitioned to change the code, and were offered five options by the FAA: GWU, GYO, GYT, SGV, and GAY. They opted to embrace what they already had instead, and introduced a line of merchandise – beanies, mugs, and more – emblazoned with the "SUX" logo.


