#### PRESIDENT'S PODIUM....

ominations and Election have been postponed at this time. Let me address some of the issues that have been going on. Back in December 2022 it was brought to the attention of the Executive Board that they were not Certified according to Statue 723 of Florida. At an executive meeting, this was mentioned and one (1) officer stated he would not get certified. VP Debra Delphi, Treasurer Carolyn Fowler and Secretary Lisa Uchida without consulting with the other 3, all became certified by taking a course of training required on December 26th. Eleven (11) days later at the membership meeting, and no mention on or before this date to any of the other Executive Board members, VP Debra Delphi stood up and suspended the 4 officers for not being certified. A round of applause was given by some members who were present only because they knew that this was going to take place.

VP Debra Delphi then positioned herself as the President. Upon doing so she appointed the following to the Board- Lee Torres as VP, 1yr Director David McClendon, 2yr Director Melissa Mazzai, and 3yr Director Christopher Bosse.

Chapter 723 does state that the vacant offices may be temporarily filled during the time of suspension. When the suspended officers did get certified by presenting a notarized statement, the Temp Board denied them. The suspended officers then took the course online and presented certificates of completion, on January 14th, 2023 to the Secretary. The Temp Board then stated

"you can come back on the board but only as Directors".

By the LAW is what that "New" Board was repeating and spreading to you the members that it was going to follow. But they didn't up hold the LAW. Hence an attorney was obtained by Keith Hutchinson and Kevin Kimball. The outcome is this –

The suspended officers once certified shall RESUME their positions on the Executive Board. The Temporary Appointed Officers were, at that time (1/14/23), relieved of their duties. Any meetings, actions, or agreements from the appointed board after such date is null and void.

Now let's talk about the Nominations and Election. On 1/22/23 the correct Executive Board called for a meeting with the Nominating Committee Chairperson. The chairperson did not show. The sign up sheet was incorrect according to the By Laws. Therefore the Executive Board voted with a majority of those present (Treasurer and VP did not attend) to postpone the nominations and election until more legal matters can be resolved. However the appointed temp officers (along with the Treasurer) still thought they could continue with the nominations, and held them anyway on 2/2/23 after being told by the Secretary on the same day just prior that they are no longer a Board Member. As stated above those actions are null and void! So is any election they may have or plan to have! Your current and active Executive Board of Officers are mentioned earlier in this Focus, but I will mention them to you as follows: President Vincent Sbrogna, VP Debra Delphi, Secretary Lisa Uchida, Treasurer Carolyn Fowler, 1yr Director Keith Hutchinson, 2yr Director Kevin Kimball, and 3yr Director Linda Roy. Kevin Kimball was appointed by me after Jim Spinos resigned 1/12/2023. Thank You.

#### You need a contractor— now what?

If you're remodeling your home and you need a contractor, what's the best way to go about getting a good one? Here are a few tips to help you find a quality con—tractor to transform your home.

- Ask your friends and acquaintances. Ask anyone who has had work done recently and find out if they were happy with the results. If they were, get the contractor's name. You also might get in contact with real estate agents in your area. It's likely they'll know who's reliable and who's not.

#### Protect your pet against poisoning

If your pet becomes poisoned, despite your efforts to keep your home safe, you'll want to be prepared.

Know your veterinarian's recommendations and procedures. Keep the numbers for your vet, the ASPCA's Animal Poison Control Center and a local emergency vet's number by the phone.

You'll also want to have a pet safety kit prepared. It should include the following:

- A fresh bottle of hydrogen peroxide.
- A can of soft dog or cat food (whichever is appropriate for your pet).
- Saline eye solution, so you can flush your pet's eyes if necessary.
- Artificial tears to lubricate the eyes after flushing.
- Mild dish washing detergent to wash your pet's skin if necessary.
- · Rubber gloves.
- Tweezers.
- A muzzle—if your pet is excited it could harm you.
- Pet carrier.


Here are some Easter safety tips:

#### Candy safety

- Make sure any toy you give to children is not a choking hazard.
- Do not give small candies to children less than 5 years old.
- Make sure you don't give any peanut-butter-filled eggs or bunnies to children who have nut allergies. Even if a chocolate candy appears to be "pure," check the label to ensure that it has not been in contact with any peanuts during preparation or packing.

#### Egg safety

- Eggs can support the rapid growth of dangerous bacteria like salmonella. Before you boil the eggs, make sure you keep them refrigerated.
- Never leave raw eggs at room temperature for more than two hours. Don't cook or eat cracked eggs that have been un-refrigerated for more than two hours.
- Hard-boiled, colored Easter eggs left in room temperature for many hours should not be eaten—they should be thrown away.
- When you boil your eggs make sure the water is between 185 degrees and 190 degrees Fahrenheit.
- Always wash your hands before and after handling eggs.


