





If You See Something, Say Something

eighborhood Watch, a division of the National Sheriffs' Association and a national program since 1972, has a presence in Colonial Village. Director Jon Lago unit #96 initiated and organized this a year ago when he invited the Largo Police Department to speak to residents. NW is an



organization of residents devoted to crime and vandalism prevention within a neighborhood with cohesiveness and collaboration with local law enforcement groups. It unites law enforcement agencies, private organizations and individual citizens in an effort to reduce crime and improve local communities. Largo Police Officers conduct few late night drive throughs in the park. New Neighborhood watch signs were installed. Officer Bowling came to two dessert functions at the park and gave informative and engaging talks to two groups of about 30 residents each. His direct line is 727-587-6730; or use the nonemergency number; do not use 911. If you SEE something, SAY something. Do NOT try to intervene or engage! Take a picture or video. First, call the Largo Police Department's non-emergency number. Second, report it to the CV office. For your own safety, LOCK doors, windows, vehicles and bikes. TAKE pictures of valuables. KNOW your neighbors. INFORM the office when you leave for a period of time. Jon is our liaison with the park and Largo Police Department. Let Jon know if you think another Community Watch event is warranted since we have so many new residents. Jon said, "I will be happy to orchestrate the refreshments. Call me with any questions". Thank you, Jon.




