As many of you are aware of there has been an ongoing erosion and deposition problem behind lots # 1-7. Doris gave us wonderful insight how to naturally alleviate this problem by plantings that are native to Florida. Phoebe Garrett is assisted by Skip Wagner in this endeavor. The plan is to start with a 20 feet section and go from there. The grass on the edge of this area will not be mowed a width of 12 to 18 inches. This will prevent the grass clippings from going into the water which is the source of one of the problems. This will also prevent the growth of algae.

We have had multiple complaints in the office about new residents not following the rules. Please read the rules and regulations you were given at orientation. We want your living experience to be very happy at Holiday Shores. Our residents take great pride in the way the park looks. This is why many of you purchased here. All exterior modifications require a work order request to be filed, appliances are NEVER allowed under the carport or around the exterior of the home, very few items are allowed within your thirty six inch perimeter. Storage bins and deck boxes are not allowed. All storage type of containers can only be under your carport and must be firmly secured to the structure in the event of high winds or hurricanes. Some folks have sheds that were grandfathered in the past. If your container/ shed was placed there after 2017, it must be moved under your carport. Thank you for your cooperation.

Pool lighting will begin March 6, 2023.

On a sad note, Pat Merl, park manager has resigned her position at Holiday Shores. We want to thank Pat for her hard work and dedication over the past five years. We all wish her well on her future endeavors and retirement.
