FROM THE MAIN OFFICE

Hello everyone and welcome to March. Sorry I missed February. I had a cold and was out of the office completely forgetting to do an article. I am all better now so here we go. We will be talking about Teakwood management needing to turn off water or electric. Often we cannot notify you. It is an emergency with water going everywhere. If we are scheduling a maintenance that will result in things being closed or shut off, we will make sure it is posted several days in advance.

So, let's talk about those emergencies. We had several in Teakwood East over the last few months and as a general rule if residents or their contractors contacted Teakwood Village office or the Call Before You Dig (811) number, they would not have hit water lines. If the water is

shut off for an emergency repair, Teakwood Village office will change the voice mail message to state that the water is off and any information we may have at that time. All calls will be routed to voice mail during the repair period.

RECAP: Call before you or someone you hire digs in order to minimize the damage to water lines (or anything else underground). If the water is off all calls will be routed to a voice message with as much information as we have at the time the message is set.

Also, a reminder that if you see standing water in your yard, please call and let us know so we can check and make sure all our water lines are intact.




