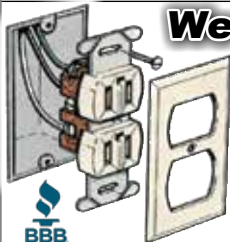

As a safety precaution, it is advisable when exiting our community from Willow Street onto Starkey that a right turn is only. Many accidents have occurred when left turns onto Starkey were attempted, and others only lucky misses. New sidewalks are in the works for both sides of Starkey Rd. They have been pouring sidewalks on the northbound side on Starkey from Ulmerton. Lanes are down to one (1) lane during the day. We cannot emphasize enough to use the RIGHT TURN ONLY rule when turning off Willow.



It is all about your safety. Remember that this is needed for our safety and part of the plan for the City of Largo to install a traffic signal at Willow / Starkey intersection with an estimated completion date of 2025.

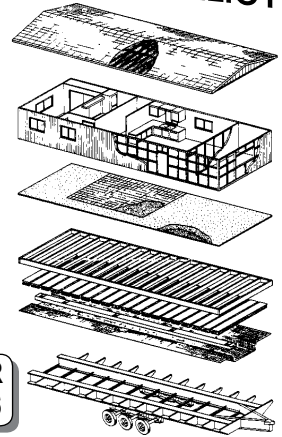

The manager is charged with the daily operation of the community including maintenance, dealing with concern forms, management of contracts, lot sales, share transfers, etc, while making sure we are following the laws, rules and practices that guide the cooperation for the benefit of all our residents. Please support Anthony and his staff in these efforts. The staff includes Jeremy, the new maintenance supervisor, Miriam our Admin and the maintenance staff. I hope you have had a chance to meet Anthony at the Meet and Greet or one of the meetings Anthony and Jeremy have attended.

Please express all your concerns with a written concern form submitted to the office for processing. Please give this new team your support and understanding.

With election season over for the HOA, PISC and Coop, I would like to congratulate all the new and returning board members and look forward to a productive year for the community to work together for the benefit of all.

The Starkey Road sidewalks project has started and our contact with the Engineering Dept. indicated a late April early May time frame for work at Willow, but it seems to be going ahead of schedule. The engineer indicated that work wouldn't cause any closure of Willow. The narrowing of Starkey to one lane would be section by section, not the entire stretch of Starkey at once. We have no control regarding this project, but will stay in touch with the Engineer for updates. The South bound side of Starkey will start after completing the North bound side. Please use extra caution during this time, and consider just turning right out of Willow to Starkey to be safe.

The Spectrum Contract is still anticipated for a April 1st start date, but that date isn't a commitment from Spectrum yet. The same contract we have had for over 4 years is still in effect and the new contract, when it starts, will last 5 years. Thanks for your patience.

With April around the corner I know some of you will start the move back to your northern home. Please plan to secure and prepare your home here so you and your neighbors don't have to worry about it. Secure possible flying objects, clean gutters and make minor repairs to prevent costly damage. Thank You in advance for that effort and support of the community.

What is the HOA and what is its mission? (Part 1)

I would like to start by thanking all who supported our Valentine's Day breakfast. We will have another breakfast March 25th. A post St. Patrick's Day event, cost and menu to be available soon. We were able, because of the increased support of Thursday Night Bingo, to increase game winning payouts to their previous levels.

We have four incorporated entities in the park and each has its own functions and responsibilities. Sometimes those responsibilities overlap. The 1st, and to some the most important, is the Co-Op. it was formed when the forward thinking residents realized that they could control their own destinies by bonding together to purchase the park rather than be subject to corporate demands for more profits for the stockholders. As I understand it, they collect assessments from all homeowners whether they own a share or not. Those who have a share, because of their \$50,000 plus share purchase, pay less than the non-shareholders. The funds they collect pay for everyone's taxes, water, sewer, trash (twice a week every week), lawn maintenance (once a week every week) cable tv and internet, maintain and operate a pool and hot tub, a spacious clubhouse with kitchen and all the utilities and costs associated with it, maintenance personnel, a Co-Op office and a management company to collect payment receipts and a park manager to handle the day to day issues that arise, contingency accounts required by law to deal with major capital infrastructure projects as well as, probably many more things. But what about the other 3 incorporated organizations? Because of space restrictions, you will have to wait for the April edition of the Monthly Media to find out. Thanks for reading.

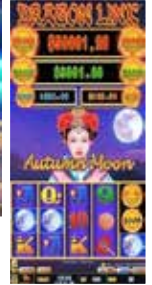

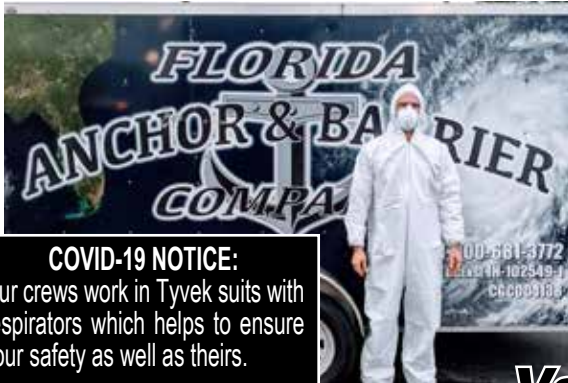

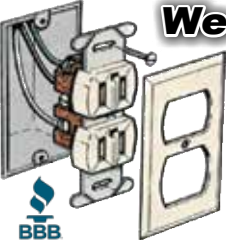

Due to back issues and having only one lung, walking can be quite a challenge for me. This Park is a wonderful place to live, not just because of the location, here in beautiful Pinellas County close to all the beaches, but because of the people that live in our park. You are such a wonderful, caring, and compassionate group of individuals; so I wanted to make sure you know how grateful I am and extend a deep, heartfelt thanks to you all!

VETERAN'S CORNER

Bob Marley first sang about Buffalo Soldiers in 1983, a little less than 120 years after the actual Buffalo Soldiers were formed in the U.S. Army. Marley's song accurately depicts their story as a fight for survival in the prejudiced Army of the time period, but they also fought to survive the harsh conditions of the frontier, conflict with native tribes and Wild West outlaws as they sought to maintain law and order and protect settlers. The Army units that would come to be known as "Buffalo Soldiers" were created during the post-Civil War Reconstruction Era. On June 28, 1866, Congress passed a legislation that allowed Black men to enlist in the peacetime army. Officially called "An Act to Increase and Fix the Military Peace Establishment of the United States," it created two regiments of all-Black cavalry and four regiments of all-Black infantry, commanded by white officers.

The original Buffalo Soldiers came from these units. The U.S. Army's 9th and 10th Cavalry were the first. Then came the four infantry units. The 38th U.S. (Colored) Infantry Regiment and the 41st U.S. (Colored) Infantry Regiment, were eventually consolidated into the 24th Infantry Regiment. The 39th and 40th (Colored) Infantry Regiments were consolidated into the 25th Infantry Regiment. They weren't the first Black men to serve in defense of the United States. Black men served in the Continental Army and state militias during the Revolutionary War. Black troops served in the War of 1812, and freedmen and former slaves fought in the Civil War for the Union Army. The 1866 legislation was the first to call for specific units composed of Black troops and recruited from Washington, Louisiana, Kentucky, Kansas and Missouri.

After its formation in New Orleans, the 39th Infantry remained in Louisiana to enforce Reconstruction laws. The 40th was sent to North Carolina for the same occupation duty, before being sent to New Orleans to form the 25th Infantry. The 41st was sent to the U.S. border with Mexico before it was merged to form the 24th Infantry to enforce laws on the Texas frontier. As the frontier moved west, the 24th was at the vanguard, manning forts and outposts, fighting

native tribes in the Plains Wars, which would continue long after the frontier was officially closed in 1890. The 24th Infantry would be the longest-serving infantry unit in the Army. It fought in the Spanish-American War, notably the Battle of San Juan Hill with future President Theodore Roosevelt's Rough Riders. They also served in the Philippine Insurrection, the Mexican Border clashes and World Wars I and II. It was the last Buffalo Soldier regiment to be integrated, which came when President Harry S. Truman desegregated the armed forces before the Korean War. The 25th Infantry also fought native tribes on the Great Plains, in the Spanish-American War, the Philippines and in World War II. The 9th and 10th Cavalry would also participate in these same American conflicts, but the 10th Cavalry Regiment would also ship off to the Mexican border during World War I, where it would clash with a Mexican force led by German advisers in a border skirmish now known as the Battle of Ambos Nogales.

In 1866, an enlistee by the name of William Cathay joined the 38th Infantry for a three-year term. After a series of illnesses sent Cathay to the hospital, it was discovered that Cathay was actually Cathay Williams, a Black woman. She was honorably discharged after the discovery, but was still the first official Black woman to enlist, and the only female Buffalo Soldier. Between 1866 and 1918, 27 members of the regiments of Buffalo Soldiers would receive the Medal of Honor for actions in the Plains Wars, law enforcement on the American frontier, the Spanish-American War and World War I. The first three Black graduates of the U.S. Military Academy at West Point were officers with the Buffalo Soldiers. Charles Young, the third graduate, would become the first Black man with the rank of colonel.

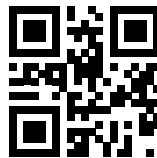

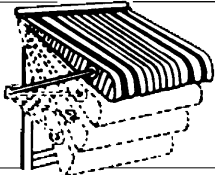
