

Subject: Monthly Activity Report: February 2023

Dear Fellow Residents: **WOW Internet Installation:** The Park and some residents are still experiencing some issues as a result of the WOW internet installation. The board will assist residents in submitting claims for expenses incurred due to damage done by the installation. Please contact the board if you need assistance.

The park submitted a claim for approximately \$16,000 to WOW for expenses incurred due to WOW related repairs.

AGM: The Annual General Meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, March 22, 2023. The second mailings were sent out to all shareholders of record in February. There are three resolutions and nine (9) candidates for board directors on the ballots. Please make sure you get your ballots in on time.

Newsworthy:

- The park has seen several paper products missing from the bathrooms. As a result, the board is procuring new paper product dispensers that will make it more difficult to "remove" these items.
- The board has received complaints regarding pet owners violating park rules including not picking up after their pets and letting pets (especially cats) run loose. Please remember to keep your pets on a leash and pick up after your pets.
- Parking of golf carts on the grass is against the Rules and Regulations.

Maintenance:

- A well water leak by the dock was found and repaired. A second well leak has been found in the same area and is now repaired.
- Two well pumps are being repaired.
- The spa was recoated and will be regrouted in about two months.
- New toilet paper dispensers were purchased and will be installed in all bathrooms.
- Volunteers repaired chairs in the hall from the park.
- Supplies to refurbish the benches by the shuffleboard courts have been ordered. Work to repair the benches should begin soon.
- The iron poles by the office/pool are scheduled to be replaced in the next two months.

- Four new cameras were purchased and will be installed in March.
- Quotes to repair the cupola on the hall are being sought.

Financial Status:

- Financial information for February will be posted in the hall.
- The audit for 2022 was completed and the report will be available by 22 March 2023 in the office for residents' review.

Town Halls: Town hall was held on February 13. The discussions included the County installation of the new water and sewer systems, a fence around Watkins Pond, and revised Rules and Regulations. The board will use lessons learned from the WOW installation to help avoid issues with the new water and sewer installation. The county committed to have a manager on site during the construction of the new systems. LSR will establish a water and sewer committee to interface with the county during the installation.

Board Meeting: A Board Meeting is scheduled for 13 March 2023 after coffee.

- Leave A/C on cool at 83 deg. Change A/C filter and batteries in thermostat.
- Cover all drains to deter insects.
- Set out roach and ant bait stations.
- Set out Damp-Away in rooms and closets to reduce humidity.
- Clean out fridge. If fridge will be turned off, prop open doors.
- Check cupboards and throw out any open foods.
- Washing machine unplug, turn off taps and prop open door.
- Leave dishwasher propped open.
- Plastic wrap toilets.







How to plant a great herb garden

f you love having fresh herbs at your fingertips here are a few suggestions on setting up a herb garden you will use and love.



- Plant your herb garden as close to the kitchen as you can manage. Your herb garden can be grown in a series of containers if that helps you locate it where it will be most convenient. If you have to go to too much trouble to get to and pick the herbs, you won't use them as much.
- If you want to get the most pleasure you can from your herbs, plant them along walkways and where people will brush up against them. They won't release their fragrances until something brushes or bruises them.
- Make sure to place your marjoram, parsley and thyme along borders. These plants only grow a few inches high and they will get lost among taller plants.
- Dill, tarragon and coriander grow up to 2 feet high. If you have a walkaround garden, the center is the best place. If your garden is up against a wall or object then you will want to place these plants at the back of the garden.
- Grow bay leaves and rosemary in clay pots just beneath the soil of your garden. When the weather turns cold, just dig them up and take them inside. They will continue to grow and you can enjoy their fragrance and flavor year round.
- Remember some herbs spread (like mint, wild marjoram and tarragon). Each year they will take more and more room. To contain their growth, confine their roots by burying a section of stovepipe. The pipe will keep them from spreading.
- Cut your herbs just before they flower for optimum flavor. That's when their oils peak. If you're going to store your herbs, it's best to cut them midmorning on a sunny day.
- Store you herbs by freezing or drying or in oil or vinegar. You can use the oil and vinegar as seasonings when you cook.
- If you have refrigerator space, keep your dried herbs there, as they will keep better. — adapted from the Big Book of Hints from Heloise by Heloise
