B e wary of online quizzes. The Federal Trade Commission is warning people of online quizzers that may seem innocent and fun, but most likely are tricking you into sharing information. For example, when

you are asked for things like the mother's maiden name, your favorite hobby, even the high school you attended, these are commonly used for online account security.

The ATC says Scammers...use your answers in an attempt to reset your accounts, letting them steal your account information. Scammers hack social media accounts and send malware links to friends of the hacked account holder under the appearance of sharing a quiz.

The agency suggests staying away from these online quizzes. Or if you take them, don't provide the truth in your responses. If you think an online quiz is a scam, you can report it at <u>http://ReportFraud.ftc.gov</u>

### **Broccoli Salad**

Combine broccoli, raisins and onion. Mix – mayo, vinegar and sugar. Pour over broccoli mixture, and toss to coat. Sprinkle with bacon. Refrigerate at least 2 hours before serving.







### How to plant a great herb garden

f you love having fresh herbs at your fingertips here are a few suggestions on setting up a herb garden you will use and love.



- Plant your herb garden as close to the kitchen as you can manage. Your herb garden can be grown in a series of containers if that helps you locate it where it will be most convenient. If you have to go to too much trouble to get to and pick the herbs, you won't use them as much.
- If you want to get the most pleasure you can from your herbs, plant them along walkways and where people will brush up against them. They won't release their fragrances until something brushes or bruises them.
- Make sure to place your marjoram, parsley and thyme along borders. These plants only grow a few inches high and they will get lost among taller plants.
- Dill, tarragon and coriander grow up to 2 feet high. If you have a walkaround garden, the center is the best place. If your garden is up against a wall or object then you will want to place these plants at the back of the garden.
- Grow bay leaves and rosemary in clay pots just beneath the soil of your garden. When the weather turns cold, just dig them up and take them inside. They will continue to grow and you can enjoy their fragrance and flavor year round.
- Remember some herbs spread (like mint, wild marjoram and tarragon). Each year they will take more and more room. To contain their growth, confine their roots by burying a section of stovepipe. The pipe will keep them from spreading.
- Cut your herbs just before they flower for optimum flavor. That's when their oils peak. If you're going to store your herbs, it's best to cut them midmorning on a sunny day.
- Store you herbs by freezing or drying or in oil or vinegar. You can use the oil and vinegar as seasonings when you cook.
- If you have refrigerator space, keep your dried herbs there, as they will keep better. — adapted from the Big Book of Hints from Heloise by Heloise
