## Bob's Corner

We have a real American hero living in our park.

A few years ago, I posted this in The Review. For those who weren't here then or never read that issue I am reposting this. Enjoy.

In the Spring of 1953, I was 7 years old, the war was winding down in Korea and talks were underway to end the fighting. But at the same time one of the bloodiest battles of the war was taking place at Pork Chop Hill. One of our neighbors, Jerry Olsen, walked right into the middle of it. I had the opportunity to sit down and talk to Jerry about his experience during those harrowing times.

Jerry started his basic training in Arkansas, and he was most likely to be in the infantry. He started training but never got to the rifle range as he and 11 other guys were "volunteered" to join communications. Luckily, he had finished bayonet training as that would be helpful later. Also, he had handled guns all his life, though never the military M1. They told him and the other "volunteers" they would have it easy as they would have nine months of training before they were deployed. "Well seven weeks later we were sent overseas" Jerry said with a grin. His job was to repair or replace radio lines for "as quick as we were laying down wire the North Koreans were cutting the lines somewhere."

On a chilly morning in April 1953 Jerry was woken up by a sergeant and told "Today is your day Olsen". Jerry thought he was going to have to clean toilets or some other chore" . But he was told "the lines were down up on Pork Chop Hill and to get 2 donuts of wire and head up there," "I grabbed some wire and my 45 and headed to the hill. "And Jerry walked into a hell on earth. He approached a bunker that had been blown up and there were four dead soldiers on the ground. All around him there were Chinese firing in his direction. He returned fire with his 45 and after emptying the 7 rounds in the gun he picked up an M1 rifle off a dead soldier and continued to fire. Jerry did not go into detail of the next two days as the memory is not pleasant and the two days he was there seemed like weeks. I am guessing the bayonet training was very helpful as well. At the beginning of that battle there were 415 men on that

hill and when it was over there were 16. Jerry was one of the survivors. On the last day he was there he was down to 3 shells and figured "well it's do or die".
"About that time a young man with clean clothes arrived and asked me what unit I was in. I told him my unit and he said, I was ordered if I was to find anyone from the 21 sat still alive to get them out of there." "By that time I was out of water and headed back down the hill."

After that day there were many sleepless nights and recurring nightmares. And although they may have subsided a little over the years they still occur from time to time. "About 3 years ago a fellow said welcome home and I thought, wow, that is the first time I was ever welcomed home. "

If you see Jerry in the park welcome him home and thank him for his service.
Note: Jerry and Carol have been married for 10 year and live at coach 230

## History of Bay Ranch

Are you like me? Have you ever wondered about the history of the place we call home; Bay Ranch?

I had the opportunity to meet with Mr. Larson and get a idea of how it all started.
Bay Ranch was originally a over 100 acre cattle ranch(cow pasture) owned by Mr. Gay (Sorry I didn't get his first name) the ranch was named after him. In 1969, four investors purchased the ranch which consisted of 4 parcels.

At this time Mr. Larson owned a development company which was hired to set the park up, develop the land and get it ready for use.

The front was started first, but the complete park was done in the same time period.
Two of the parcels were sold off, one for a family park and the other became Westgate.
In 1971 one of the investors wanted out and that is when Mr. Larson bought into the park.
They started bringing in 35-40 homes at a time. It helped that one of the investors was in mobile homes, so they had a good resource for that. All homes were set up as a turnkey situation. They were ready to be moves in and occupants could immediately start enjoying their time here. It took approximately 5 years to have full occupancy.

In 1984 Mr . Larson bought out the remaining three partners. Mr. Gay moved and started another ranch, so this is when the name was changed to Bay Ranch as he took back the Gay Ranch name in his new location. (He just loved cattle)

When Bay Ranch first started it was mostly the "Snow birds" or our northern friends as the main occupants. Mr. Larson thought the park would always be primarily occupied that way and didn't see the change in pre-dominantly full time residents that we now have. He closed by saying we have a good group of people here.


## Variety Show

The Variety Show was a huge success! Lots of people attended, and those who didn't, well, they missed something special.

The acts were truly varied: we had vocal solos and groups, comedy skits and standup, dance and combinations of the above. "A Minute to Win It" game show became part of the program for the first (or last?) time.

The show opened with the presentation of the flags and the 2 national anthems, followed by a special version of Leonard Cohen's "Hallelujah" honoring the veterans in our park.

A rousing version of "New York, New York" kicked off the entertainment. Master of Ceremony Wayne Jones did his usual wonderful job of introducing each act. Good Humor Man Ed Zygmunt amused us with funny stories while the stage crew (Charlotte Augustine, Paul Puerling and Patty Holden) set up the stage and microphones. A yummy table of goodies donated by residents was served by Patty Harwood and her crew.

Many of the acts were performed by the Variety Show regulars, but as is true every year, some new acts volunteered. The crowd pleaser was Vicky Baumann singing "This Is the Moment" from the "Jeckyl and Hyde: The Musical;" and to the delight of the audience, Roger Heil replaced Jim Jones as the butt of "the walker girl's" humor. The acts were accessorized by interesting costumes (see the Babe Ranchers as flappers and not-so-humble Carol Olson), a lighted jukebox, and a backdrop of a smoky tavern. The 50/25/25 winners received $\$ 28$.

So many contributed to the success of the show, setting up, tearing down, singing along with the acts, cheering on Paul Bartman: No way can there be a complete list, but you know who you are.
