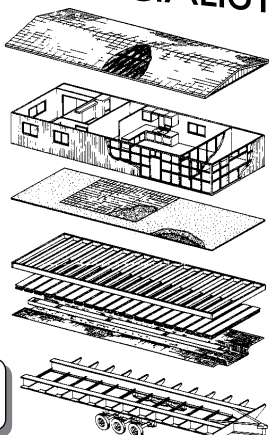

MARRIAGE AND CHILDREN

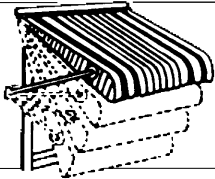

- The SIGN-IN/SIGN OUT FORM is inserted in this month's edition of the Spotlight.
- Please don't throw it out! It is also available at the Office and on the Website under: "Residents then SIGN-IN/SIGN OUT FORM". Filling it in (and returning it to the Office) will ensure your water bill stops while you are away and park management is then aware you are not home.
- Turn water off at the tap at the back of your house and underneath your house.
- Cover your toilet bowls with plastic wrap and place something heavy on top.
- Close your sink drains to keep critters from entering your home.
- Leave air conditioner on (between 80F and 85F) to minimize potential mold issues.
- Place either cat litter, charcoal, or Damp Rid around inside your home to absorb moisture.
- Unplug electrical items, for example computers, TV, coffee makers etc.
- Golf cart - check what is recommended for your cart.

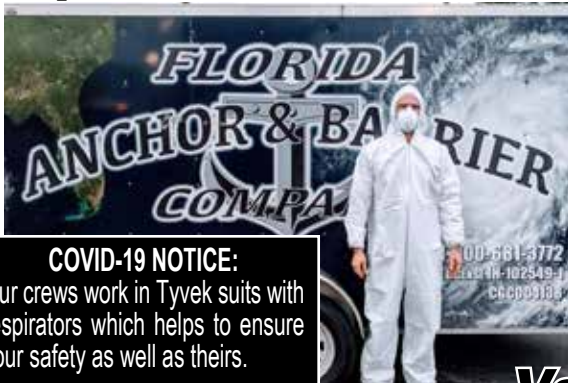
