Rules Reminder – Item 20(F) the Declaration of Master Occupancy Agreement pertains to alterations to the units. It reads, "The Unit Owner shall not, without first obtaining the written consent of the corporation, alter the unit in any way or add to the mobile home presently located upon the unit or any of its fixtures and appurtenances. The unit owner shall not change the color of the mobile home located on the unit, or substantially alter its outward appearance without first having obtained the approval thereof from the Directors."

CROSS BAYOU

ur committee had a very successful meeting with the residents on February 11 at the CWC Clubhouse. There was a great turnout with many questions and concerns brought forth. Don Reich explained what the biggest problem we are facing with the canal issue involving the culverts at the Bayou Club. Nat Croucher provided me with additional photographic evidence of the blockages, pollution, trash and sandbars on the south end of our property and under the Belcher Bridge. This has caused a big problem for our wildlife, manatees, fish, ducks, otters. Another resident, Toni Cusick and her husband provided a list of agencies that have conservation volunteers which deal with preserving wildlife. Our wildlife has depleted due to the negligence by the county to preserve and maintain the waterway. On February. 21st, we had an Engineer come out to evaluate our problem. We now have an engineer report on hand.

With the backing and interest of the residents from that meeting, I signed up to be a speaker at the Pinellas County Delegation on February 27th in Clearwater. Tim and Tracy Caddell met with me and we discussed the speech. We had three large PDF files of everyone we have contacted since May, 2021, to give to Chair Hooper's aide and I made an additional 12 packets for the delegates.

I met with Debbie Creighton who helped design our great signs SAVE OUR BAYOU, that I attached to paint sticks so the residents could hold them up when it was my turn to speak. We all carpooled and met at the Arts Center with our Save our Bayou Signs.

When my name was called to speak, the residents held up the signs. What an impact that made to the delegates. I presented our case, and thanked them for allowing us to speak. Senator Hooper told us to contact Representative Jacques and Nick DiCeglie for assistance.

The next day Representative Jacques' office was contacted and we obtained an appointment for March 1st. Connie and Tom Kastner, Bart Rosario and myself responded to his office. Rep. Jacques stated he would contact the county to inquire why they haven't tried to help us. He told the county to get hold of their engineers and associates and provide a solution and forward it to his Aide Amanda.

At our Meet and Greet with City Council, the Mayor, Vice Mayor and Bart Diebold told us that WE GOT THE COUNTY'S ATTENTION, and continue, don't stop. They are proud of us.

April Fools' Day

April Fools' Day, also called All Fools' Day, in most countries

the first day of April. It received its name from the custom of playing practical jokes on this day—for example, telling friends that their shoelaces are untied or sending them on so-called fools' errands. Although the day has been observed for centuries, its true origins are unknown and effectively unknowable. It resembles festivals such as the Hilaria of ancient Rome, held on March 25, and the Holi celebration in India, which ends on March 31.

Some have proposed that the modern custom originated in France, officially with the Edict of Roussillon (promulgated in August 1564), in which Charles IX decreed that the new year would no longer begin on Easter, as had been common throughout Christendom, but rather on January 1. Because Easter was a lunar and therefore moveable date, those who clung to the old ways were the "April Fools." Others have suggested that the timing of the day may be related to the vernal equinox (March 21), a time when people are fooled by sudden changes in the weather.

There are variations between countries in the celebration of April Fools' Day, but all have in common an excuse to make someone play the fool. In France, for example, the fooled person is called *poisson d'avril* ("April fish"), perhaps in reference to a young fish and hence to one that is easily caught; it is common for French children to pin a paper fish to the backs of unsuspecting friends. In <u>Scotland</u> the day is Gowkie Day, for the gowk, or <u>cuckoo</u>, a symbol of the fool and the cuckold, which suggests that it may have been associated at one time with sexual license; on the following day signs reading "kick me" are pinned to friends' backs. In many countries newspapers and the other media participate—for example, with false headlines or news stories.
