Even though she couldn't get around well, others helped her to her appointments, etc. that does not mean she gave up driving all together ... That gal had a golf cart and she used it quite often. Allow me to share a little "Dot story" of my own that rattled my nerves when she told me what she did ...!

Dorothy had asked me to go to Michael's craft store for a certain kind of needle for her project. I went but couldn't find that particular needle. I went back and told her that specific needle was not in the store. I was willing to go to JoAnn Fabrics. She said not to, I thought the subject was temporarily closed. The next time I went over to her place she had her needle, it looked similar to the letter C. I was so surprised and asked her where she found it because I had one of them in my needle box.

WELL...sometime after I left her the other day she had gotten herself into her <u>golf cart - drove</u> to <u>Michael's and bought herself that needle!</u> I asked how she did that (she was 91 yrs old and not too steady on her feet) her story was filled with helpful people assisting her out of her cart, into the store and back into her cart. It was a thrilling, chilling story of high adventure, oh my!!!







Later, when Disney spent an unprecedented \$1.5 million to produce the masterpiece Snow White, critics and naysayers dubbed the project "Disney's Folly." 


Believe in yourself
