### **RECIPE OF THE MONTH**

#### Chocolate Banana Cake

Ingredients:

- <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup +2 TBS butter
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 TBS Olive Oil
- 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cups flour
- 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> tsp baking powder
- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> tsp baking soda
- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup cocoa powder
- 2/3 cup sour cream
- 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> cups very ripe bananas (about 4), mashed
- 1 TBS vanilla extract
- 3 large eggs

#### Directions:

- Pinch of salt 6 oz chocolate chips
- Icing: (Heat on stove)
- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup butter
- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> to <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cups sugar
- 4 oz chocolate chips
- 2 TBS light corn syrup
- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> cup heavy cream

1. Preheat oven to 325 degrees. Oil or spray 9-inch springform cake pan, set aside. In a large saucepan, over low heat, combine butter, olive oil and sugar. Melt, then remove from heat and transfer to mixing bowl.

- 2. Add flour, baking powder, baking soda, salt and cocoa to the melted mixture. Then add sour cream and mashed banana; whisk to combine. Mix eggs and vanilla in a separate bowl, then add to the mixing bowl and whisk until smooth. Fold chocolate chips into the mixture.
- 3. Pour into prepared cake pan. Bake until cake tester comes out clean (about 45 minutes). Allow cake to cool on rack for 12-15 minutes.
- 4. Prepare icing while cake is cooling. In a medium saucepan, combine butter, cream, chocolate chips and sugar. Stir over medium heat until completely smooth and warm.
- 5. While cake is still warm --- but not hot --- turn out of the pan onto a cake plate. Poke holes all over the top of the cake. Dribble icing over the cake several times giving icing a chance to seep in the warm cake and drip down the sides. Extra icing can also be used for topping each slice when served.

### **BUYER BEWARE!**

The latest scam trending in Pinellas County involves the Visa Gift cards you see at grocery stores, drug stores and other places that sell gift cards. This is how it works:

Bad guy takes four or five cards off the store rack, opens them, records the card number, enters the number online, removes one or two of the card digits to ensure the victim cannot use it before he does, glues them back together and places them back on the rack for an unsuspecting customer to purchase and load with money. Once the card is loaded (by

the victim) the bad guy is notified online, and he can spend YOUR money.

When you buy gift cards:

1. Grab a gift card from the middle of the stack (most bad guys leave the fraudulent card at the front of the stack so it is purchased quickly).

2. Open the card at the register before you load it. Look for extra glue under the back flap or security seal (this is a clue that it is a scammer's card) and check the number of digits on the front of the card. (There should be 16 — four sets of four digits. If there are missing numbers, it is a clue that it is a scammer's card.)

If you suspect a scam, let the clerk or store manager know. Please don't put the card back on the rack and don't load money on it. Shop Safely.

### **NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH**

ave you ever noticed how Embassy Park is a quiet, safe neighborhood? That is, in part, because of the excellent work of our Neighborhood Watch volunteers.

What is Neighborhood Watch? A neighborhood watch program is a group of people living in the same area who want to make their neighborhood safer by working together and in conjunction with the local law enforcement to reduce crime and improve quality of life in the community. Neighborhood watch groups typically focus on observation and awareness as a means of preventing a crime. Simply put, it is neighbors watching out for the welfare of each other.

Why do we need a Neighborhood Watch program at Embassy? When we started the program, about 4 1/2 years ago after an attempted break-in at an occupied residence, 20-30 calls per month were made for police assistance. The calls were for a variety of reasons — suspicious people, suspicious activities, people living in residences who didn't belong there, groups of people walking on our streets who didn't live here — to name a few. That went on for months. It took the Park Management and the Neighborhood Watch program probably a year or more to start bringing down the number of calls.

What are the Neighborhood Watch volunteers expected to do? Volunteers clad in safety vest and armed only with a whistle, drive up and down the streets of our park looking for anything/ anyone suspicious or out of place. When riding in a golf cart or on bicycle, it is best to have a 'buddy' with you. Some volunteers use their vehicles to patrol. The whole point is not to make a personal contact with anyone that looks suspicious because that could lead to an altercation. Officer Bowling advises against confronting a suspicious person as you open yourself to an attack. Instead, always carry a cell phone and have it ready to make the call — whether administrative or 911 and Largo PD or Pinellas Sheriff. Law enforcement personnel are trained to handle any situation. They want us to make the call.

Do we have to buy our own vest and whistle? Sadly, yes. But both items are readily available at low cost online and at the local WalMart store.

Want to help but don't have a golf cart or bicycle? You can still be a program volunteer. Come to a meeting and someone will brief you on the basics of the program and, if possible, pair you with another volunteer for patrols. But you don't have to drive the streets to participate. You can also do your part by simply keeping an eye on your own street. Watch out for cars or people that don't belong there. Keep an eye on your neighbor's home when you know they are away. If you see something, report it to the police.

To summarize, a Neighborhood Watch program only works when there are volunteers working to keep their community safe. We are always looking for volunteers and ask everyone who is interested to attend one of our meetings at 1:00 p.m. on the last Thursday of every month. Or you can stop any of the Neighborhood Watch members you see patrolling and ask them when/ where to attend the next meeting. We'd love to see there!

## IT AIN'T OVER YET!

s you all know by now, the Embassy Park Fun Night event normally held in March was cancelled this year. And many feared it was gone forever. But it ain't over, yet. ### GARBAGE

Would like to start this article out on a positive note. I am very impressed by all the residents that take the time to push garbage to the back of the dumpsters, move the wrong items out of the recyclable bins into the garbage, etc. Several residents even arrive with a broom and dustpan to sweep the area around the dumpsters. Big Mike does this on a regular basis. By now most residents are aware that I have installed cameras, I have heard comments, such as: I have to break down my boxes, SHE has a camera now. I have had items returned to the offenders when possible; other times I send a letter. If Chuck or I happen to see errors made in this area, we have a speaker feature where we can talk to whoever is not following the guidelines for correct garbage and recycle procedures.

There is a list of items posted regarding what items can go into the recycle bin; the important thing is to break all boxes flat to allow more room in the dumpster.

By no means does this mean everything is perfect, but it is getting there.

Garbage rules are still the same, no yard waste, tree clippings, household items, etc. are allowed in the 6 yd dumpsters.....these items belong in one of the two 30 yd dumpsters, either the one on 3rd street or the one on 2nd street, which is for brush ONLY! This second dumpster is for tree trimming and unbagged yard waste only and it is temporary, I plan to have it picked up soon.

Curbside waste is for larger items that you can't take care of yourself, such as small furniture/ decorative items, etc. NO TV'S OR ELECTRONICS, the office has the information you need on how to dispose of them, along with paint. You can open your paint cans, let the paint dry out, then put them in the 3rd street dumpster. Another trick is to put kitty litter in them to speed up the drying process (buy the cheap stuff, I think the Dollar Store may sell it). Yard waste and tree trimmings are to be: Bagged, Boxed or Bundled or they won't be picked up at all.

When can I put my garbage out? This has never changed....it is not supposed to be put out ....continued on page 35

until after 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, Tuesday and Thursday for early morning pick up on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. If you miss getting it out on time, keep it in your shed until the next pick-up day, no one wants to see garbage out at the curb so several days. In fact, I have told maintenance to NOT pick up your garbage if you have put it out too early.

Mondays are a big trash day; often there is no place to put garbage so we end up leaving it in the park trailer so it can be taken care of as soon as the dumpsters are emptied. This means if you have bagged, boxed or bundled yard waste it may not get picked up until Tuesday.

A lot of Canadian residents and guests have made comments about the lack of recycling here. Go online and read all the articles about what plastics, chemicals, etc. are doing to our waterways and eco systems,

Thank you in advance for your continued efforts to keep the garbage area clean 24/7 and by doing your part by recycling.


